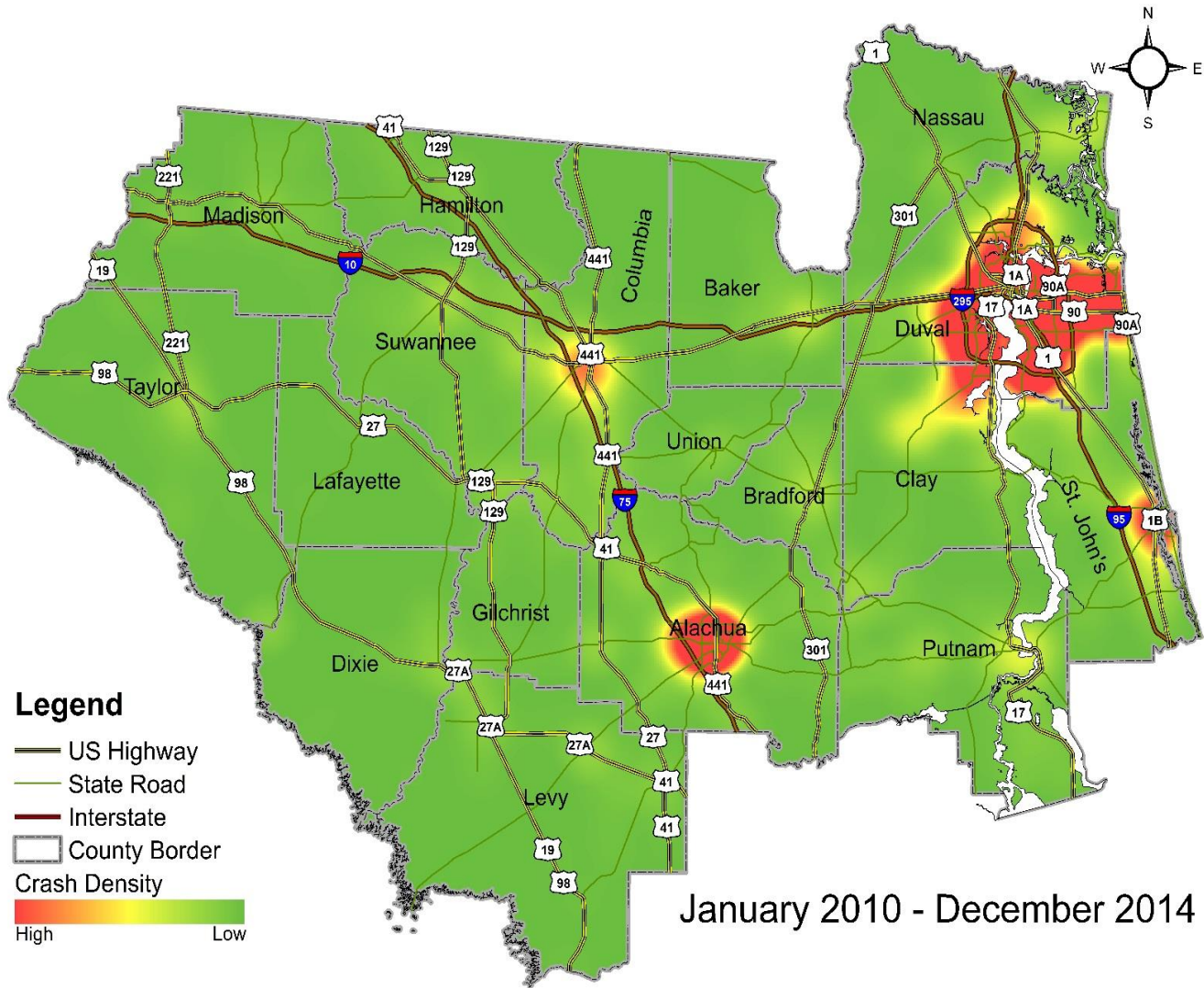


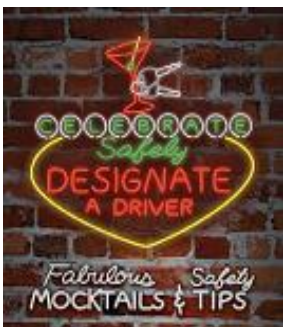

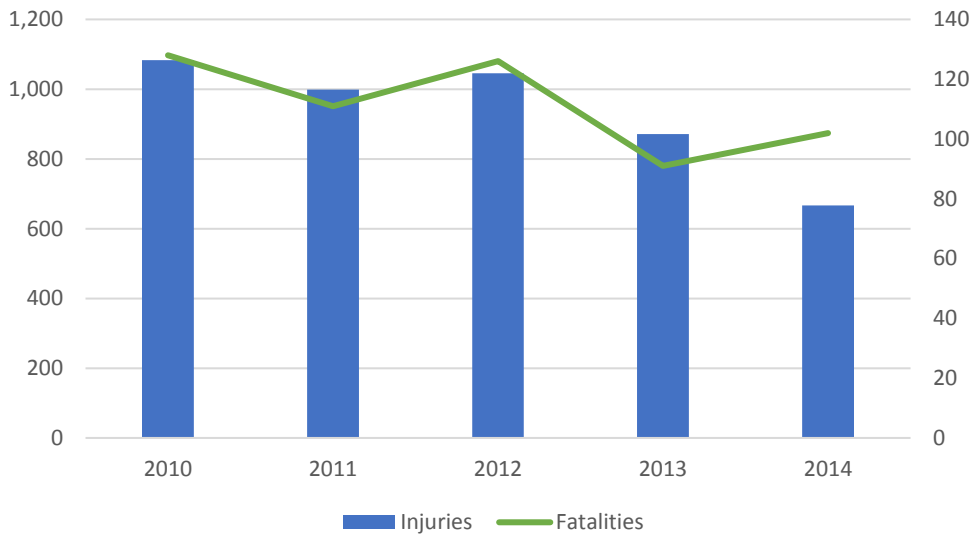

2014 at a Glance

*Data was obtained from the Florida Department of Highway Safety Motor Vehicle (DHSMV) Long Form Crash Report as reported by the officer. These numbers may vary from other studies due to the manner in which the data was analyzed. Crash data is utilized if certified by the State Safety Office as complete.



The Florida Strategic Highway Safety Plan (SHSP) identifies Impaired Driving as an emphasis area. Impaired driving is defined as driving under the influence of drugs or impaired by alcohol. It is unlawful for a person under the age of 21 to operate a motor vehicle with a blood-alcohol level or breath-alcohol level of 0.02 or higher (referred to as zero tolerance); 0.08 is the legal limit for drivers 21 and older.

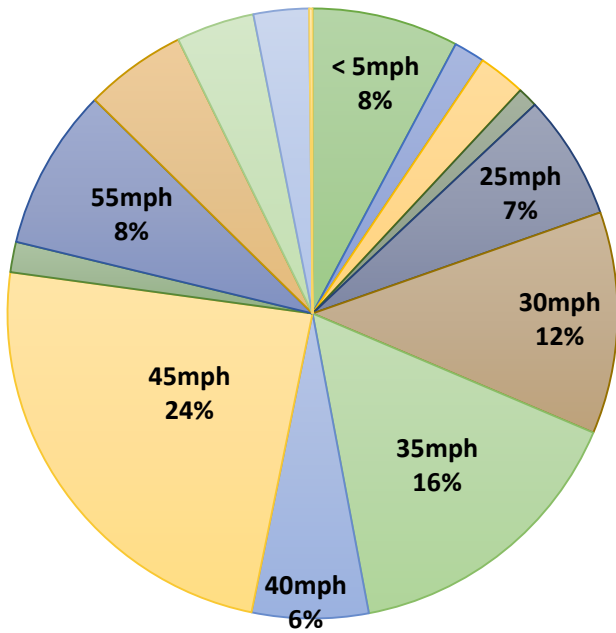

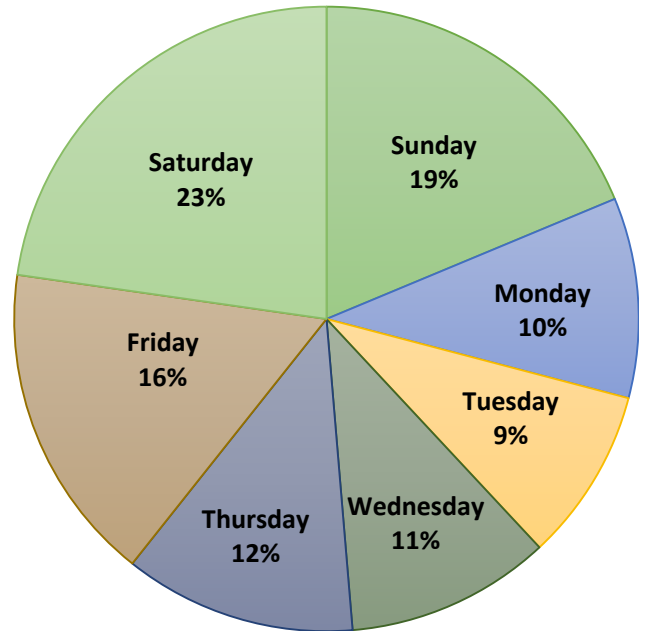

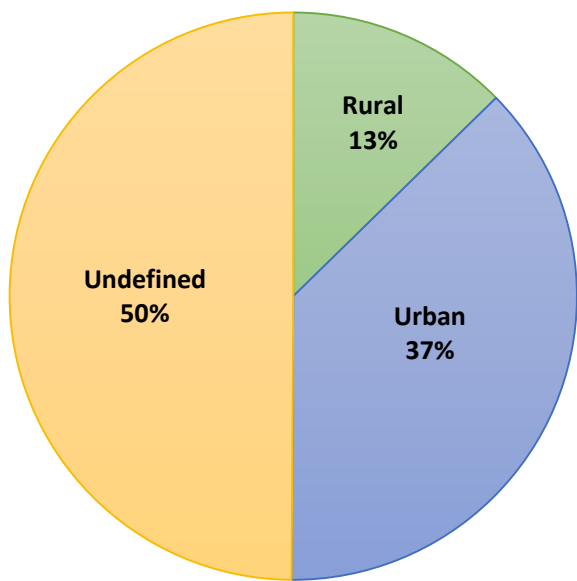
Maximum Speed
