### 2017 Impaired Driver Crash Data Summary

Impaired crashes are identified as those that include any of: Suspected drug/alcohol use, driver condition is under the influence of medication/drugs/alcohol, refused an alcohol/drug test, has blood alcohol content greater than zero, or has a drug result of positive.

**29 Crashes • 2 Fatal • 5 Incapacitating • 6 Non-Incapacitating • 4 Possible Injury • 12 PDO\***

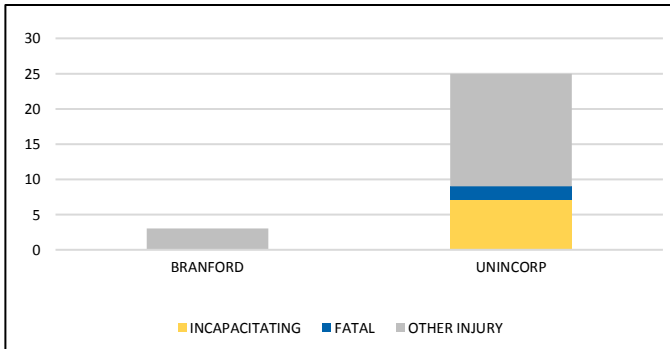
Note: Crash severity is determined from the highest injury type in the crash (i.e. if a crash had both a fatal and an incapacitating, it is determined to be a fatal crash).

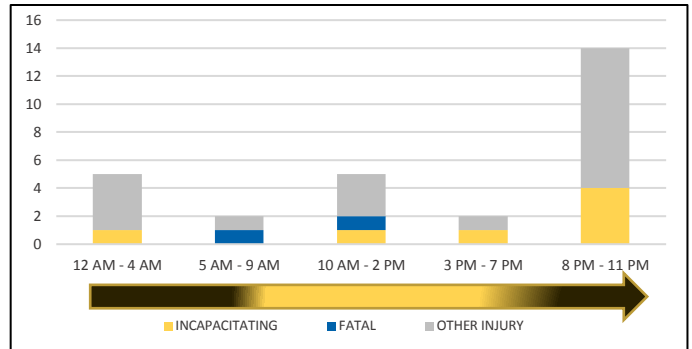

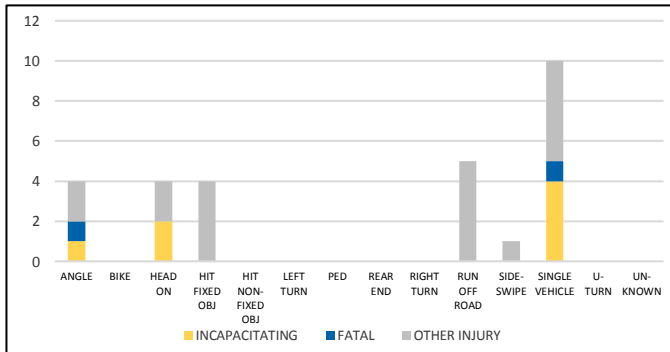

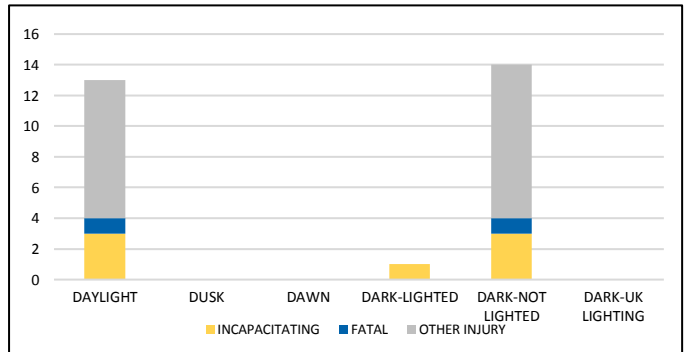
**TIME OF DAY**



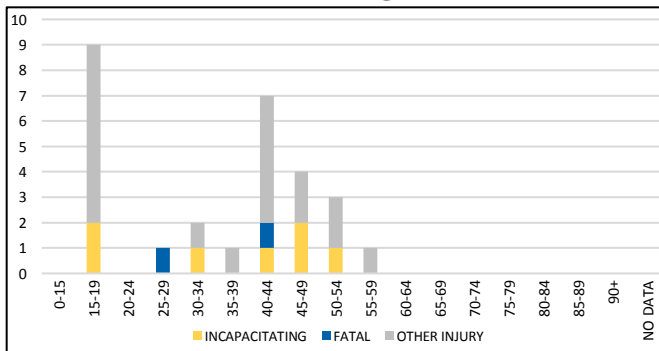
**CRASH TYPE**



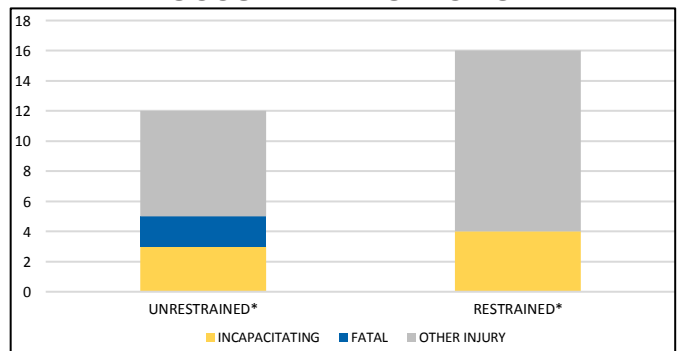
**LIGHTING**
