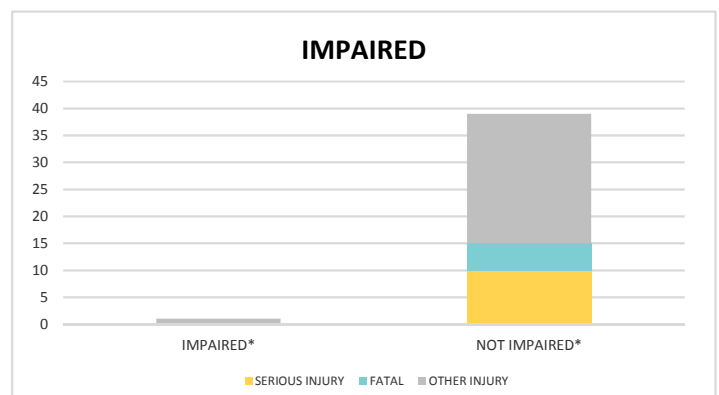
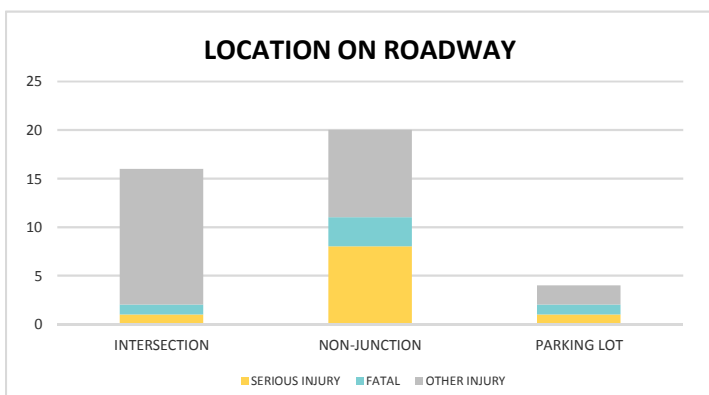
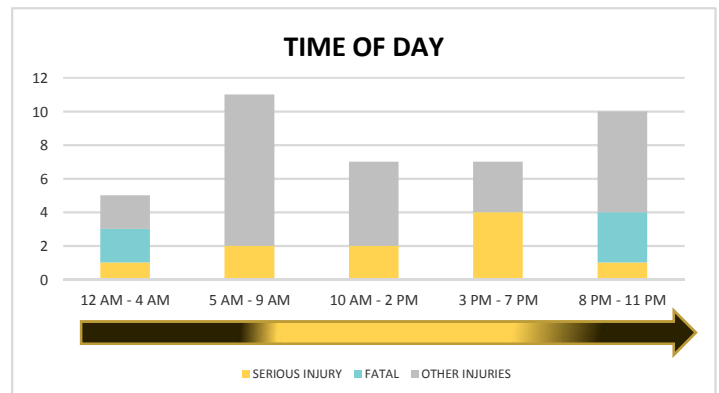
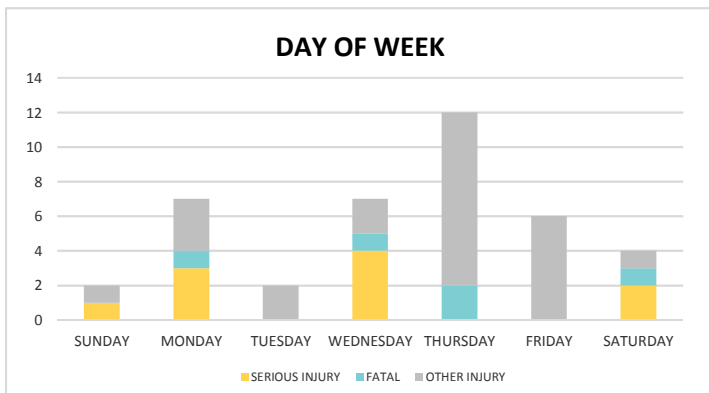


# 2018 Pedestrian Crash Data Summary

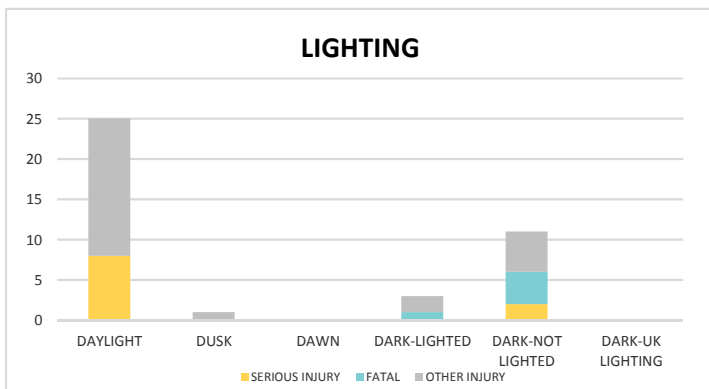


Severity	Crashes	People Injured
Fatal	5	5
Incapacitating Injury	6	10
Non-Incapacitating Injury	10	16
Possible Injury	6	9
No Injury	5	NA

Note: Crash severity is determined from the highest injury type in the crash (i.e. if a crash had both a fatal and a serious it is determined to be a fatal crash).

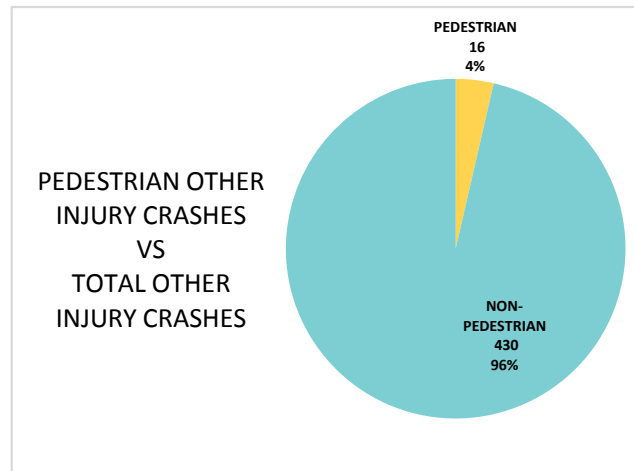
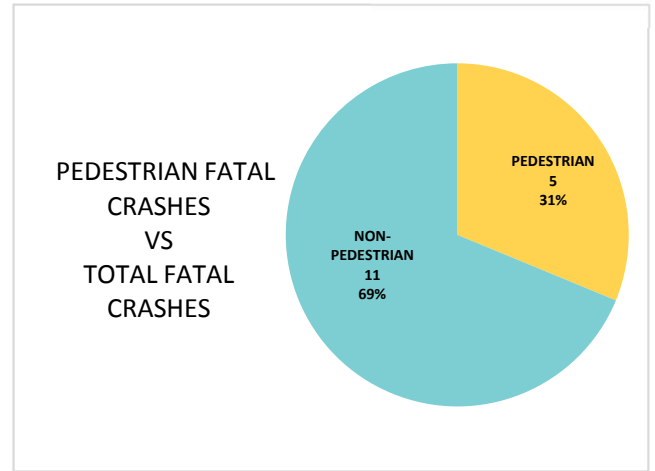
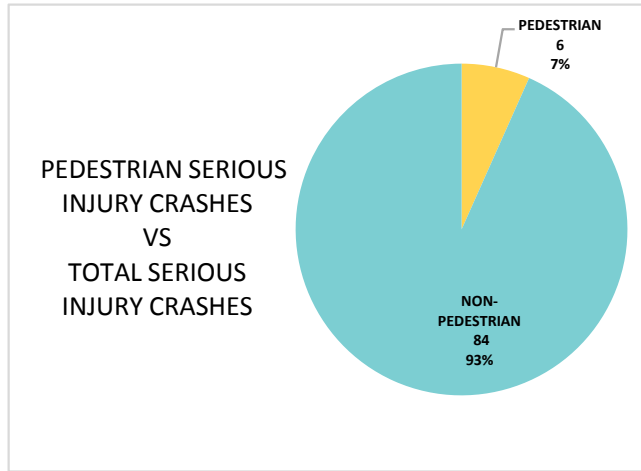
