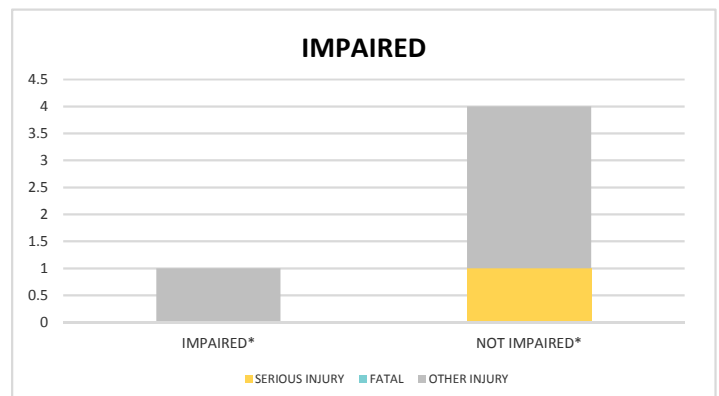
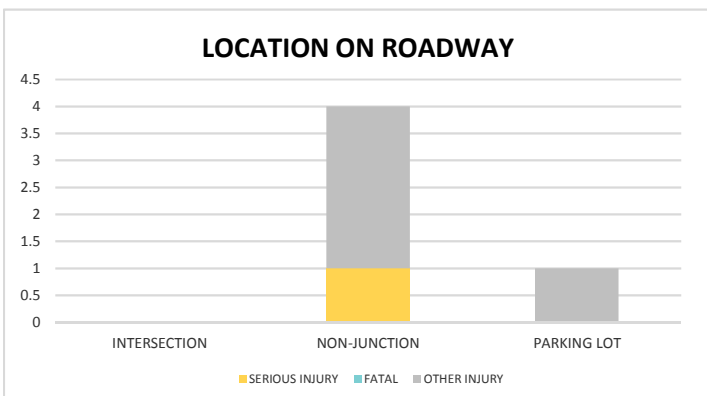
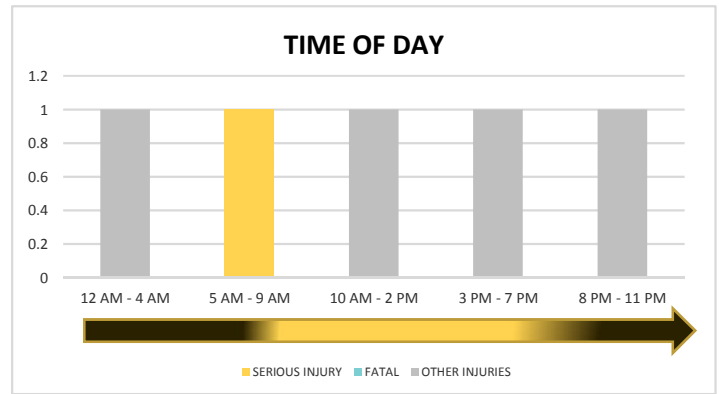
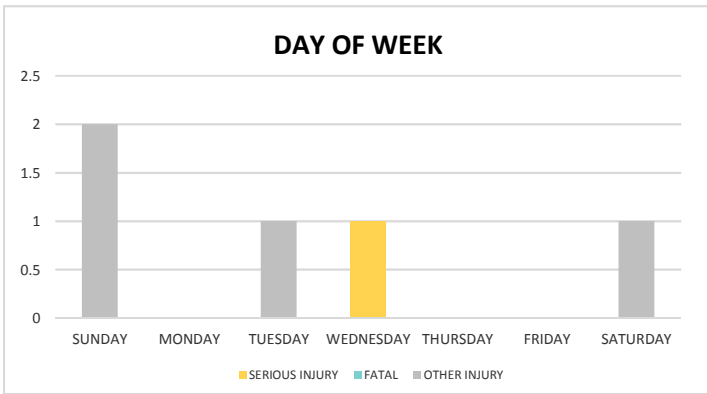


# 2018 Pedestrian Crash Data Summary

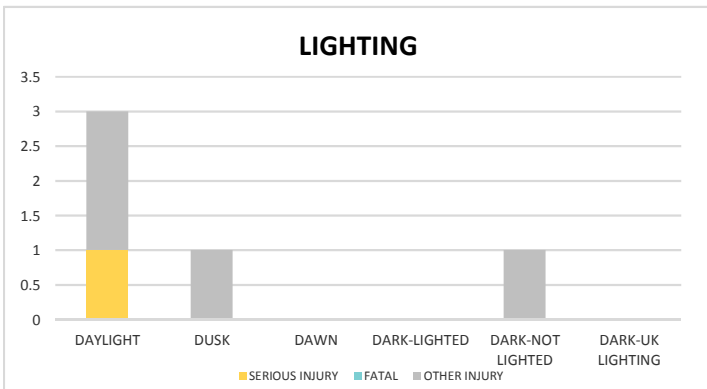


Severity	Crashes	People Injured

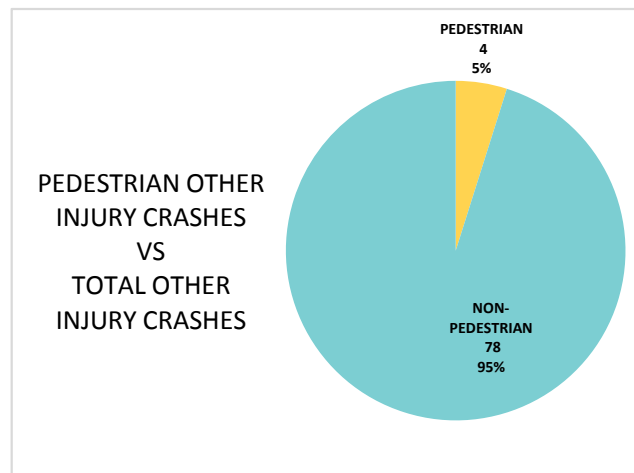
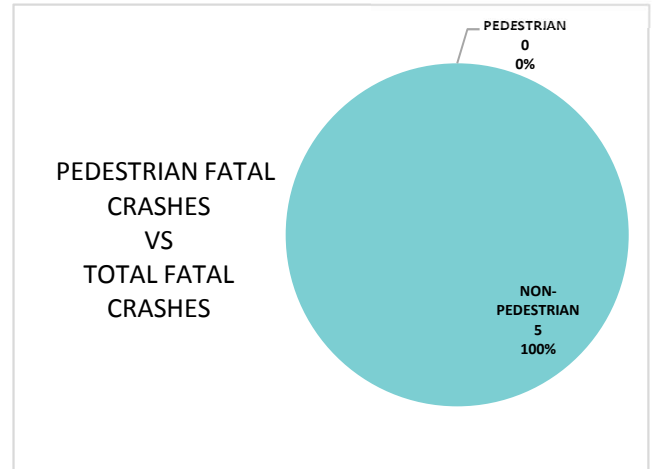
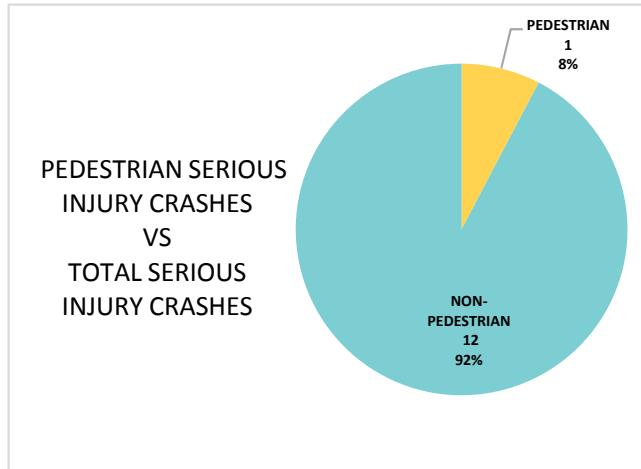
