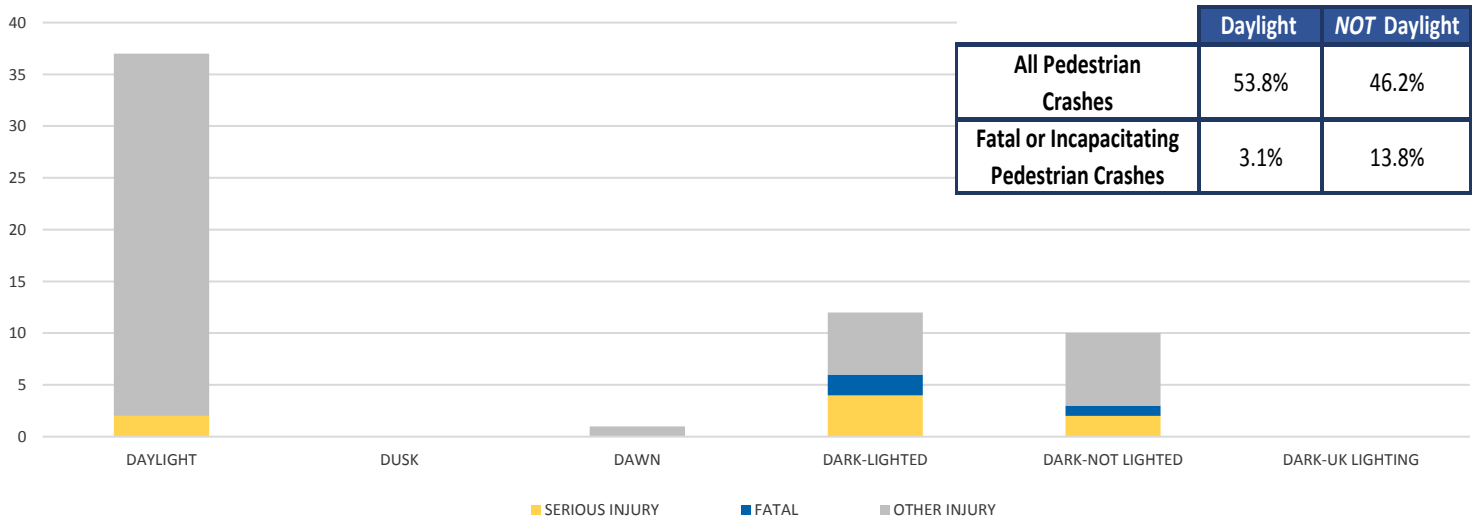

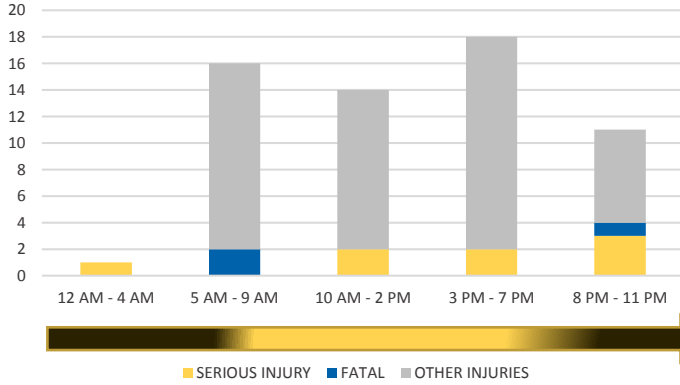

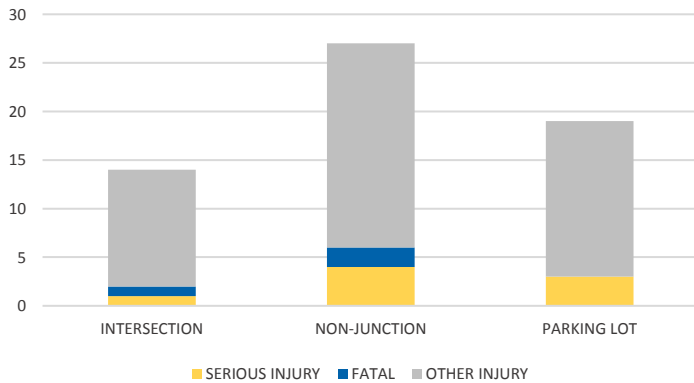

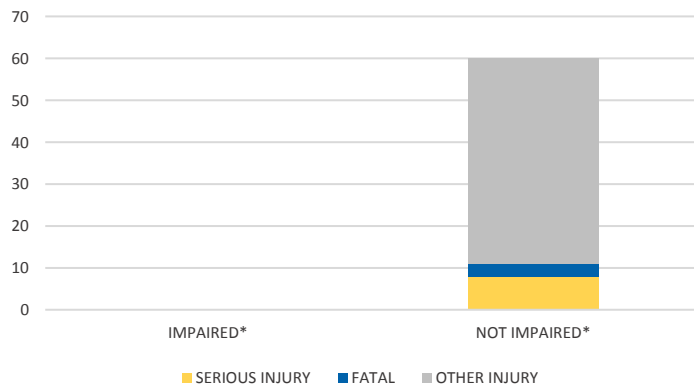
TIME OF DAY



LOCATION ON ROADWAY



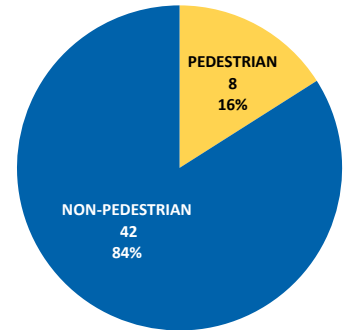

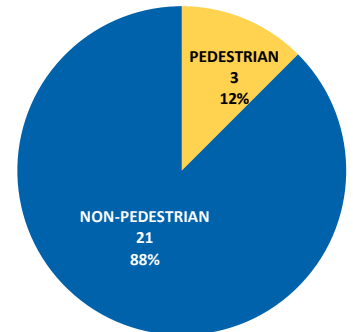
