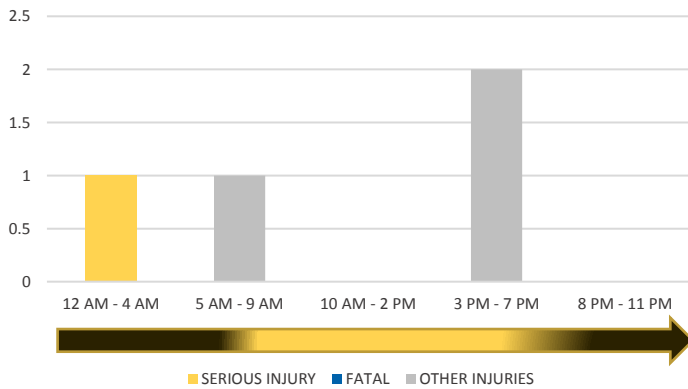

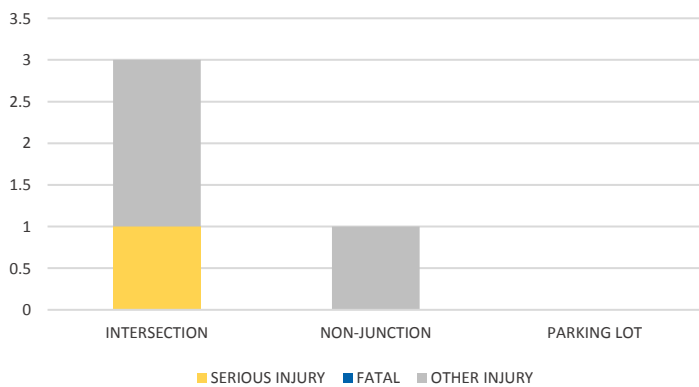

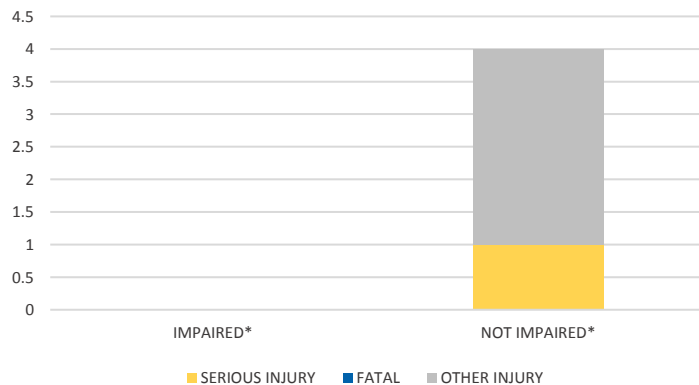
TIME OF DAY



LOCATION ON ROADWAY



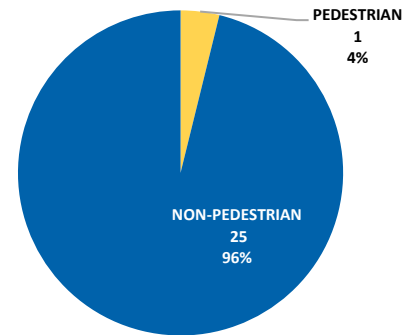

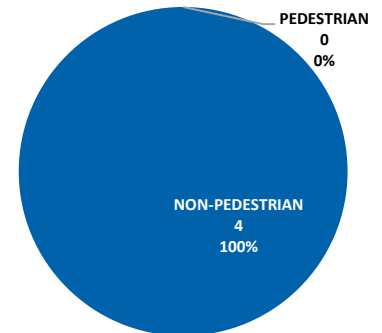

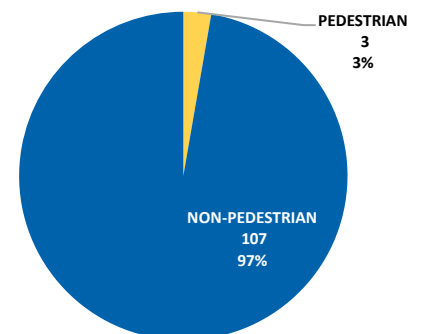
PEDESTRIAN SERIOUS INJURY CRASHES VS TOTAL SERIOUS INJURY CRASHES
