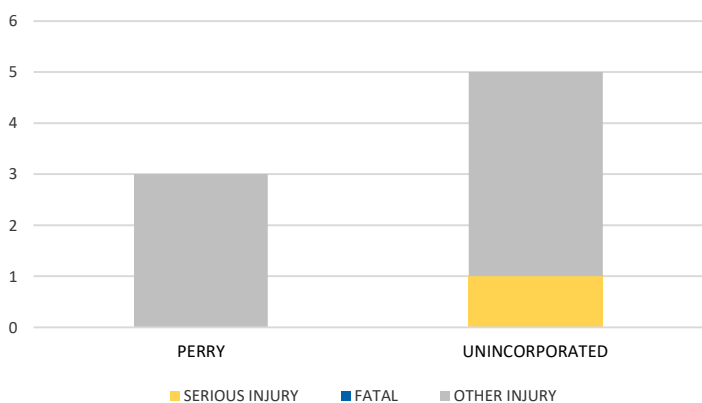

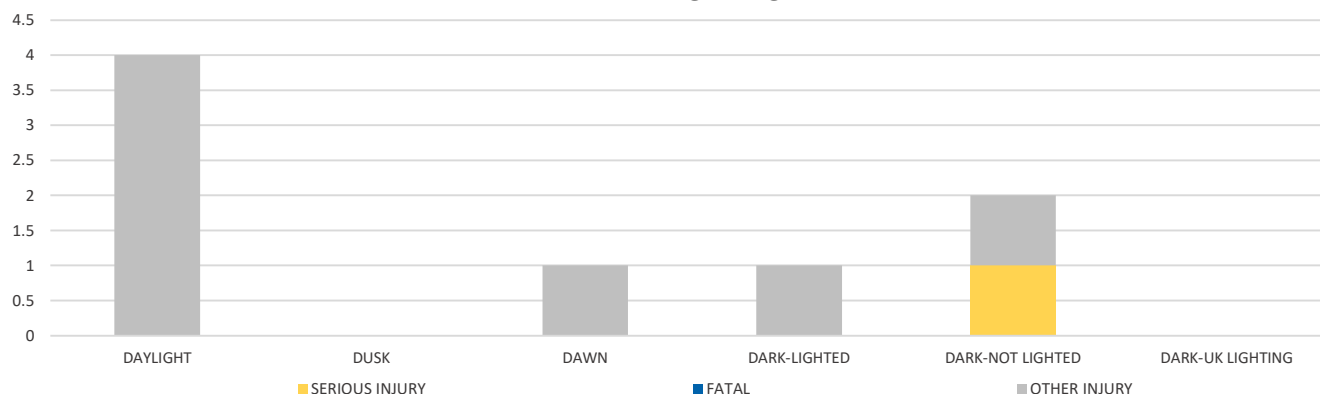

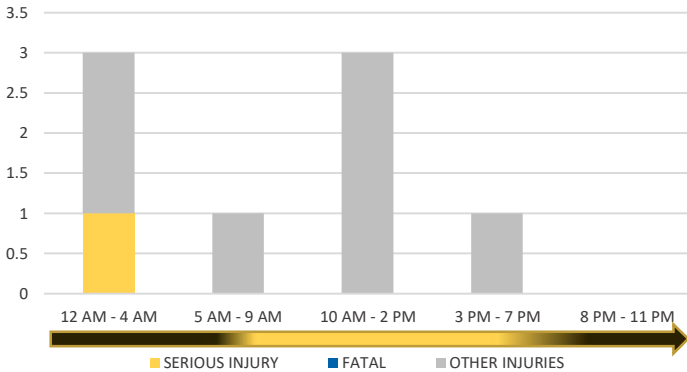

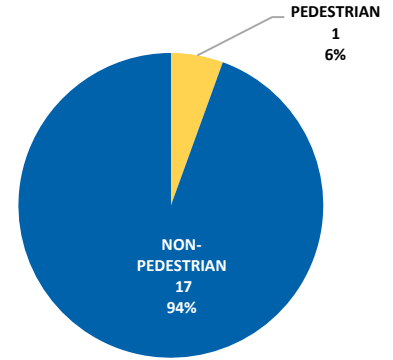

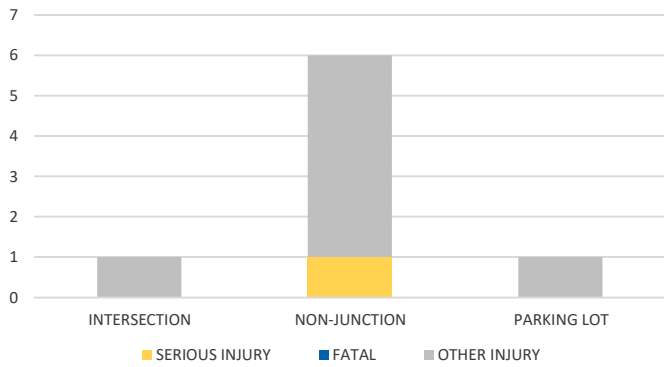
TIME OF DAY



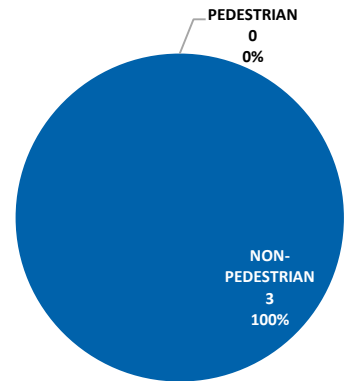
PEDESTRIAN SERIOUS INJURY CRASHES VS TOTAL SERIOUS INJURY CRASHES



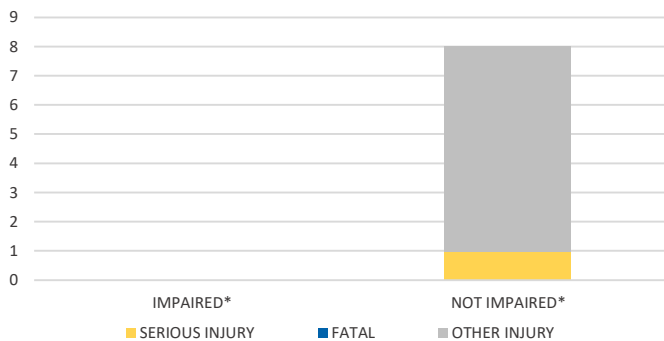
LOCATION ON ROADWAY



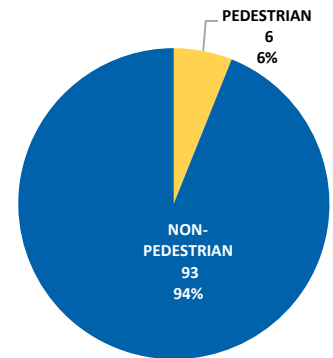
PEDESTRIAN FATAL CRASHES VS TOTAL FATAL CRASHES
