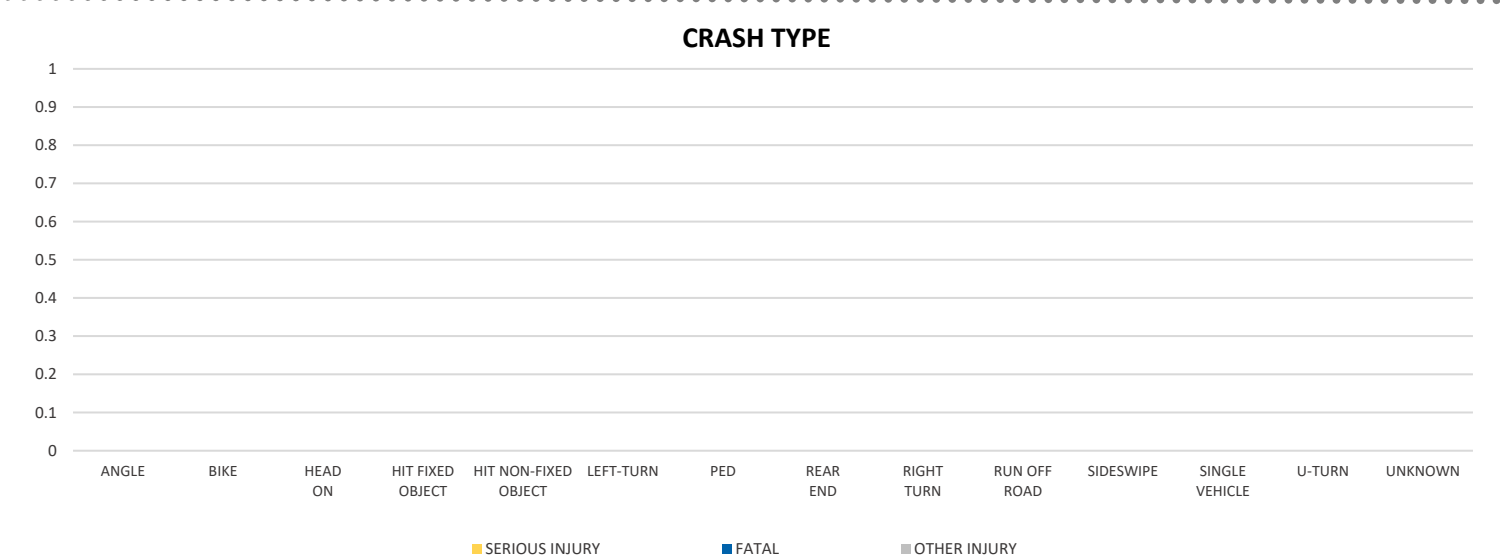

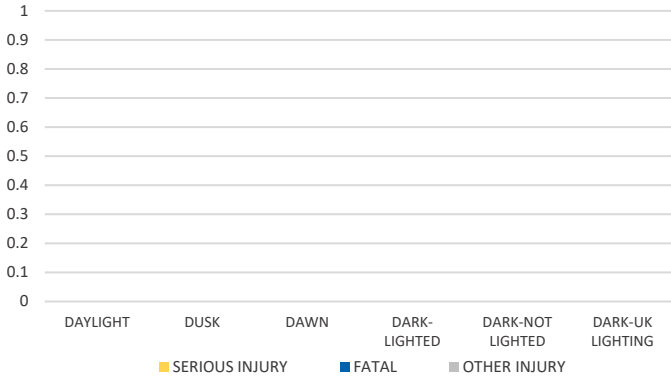

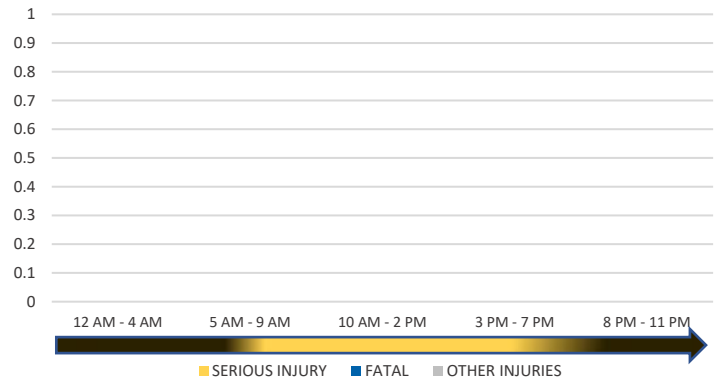

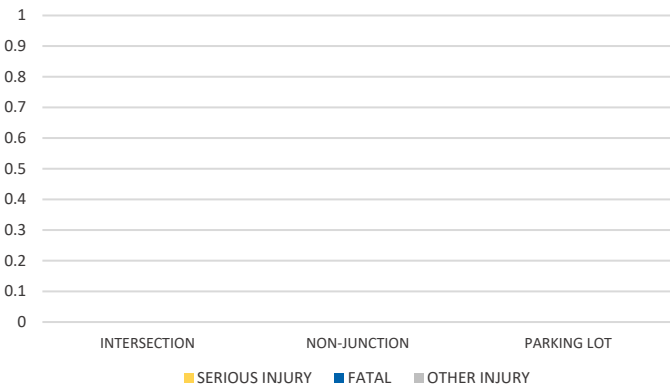

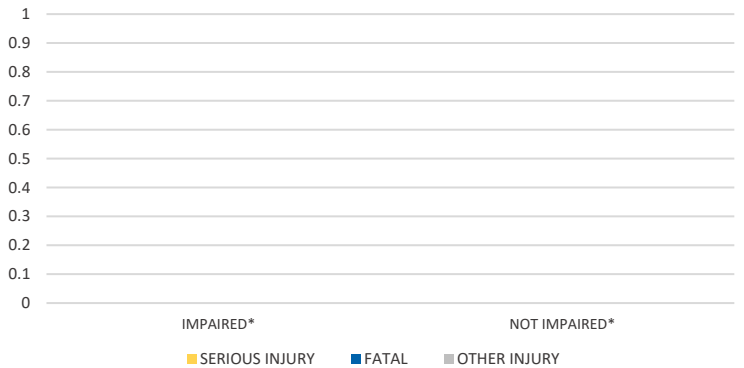
TIME OF DAY
