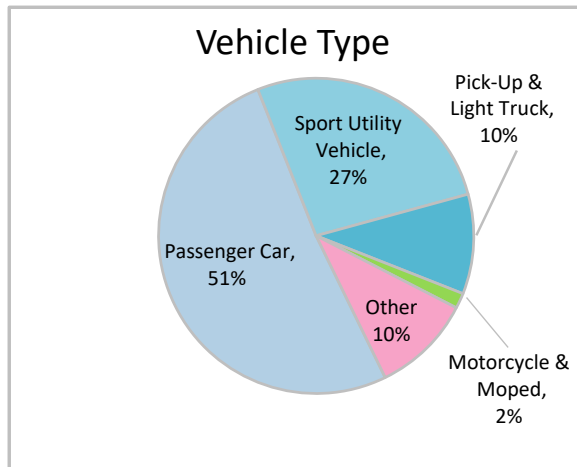
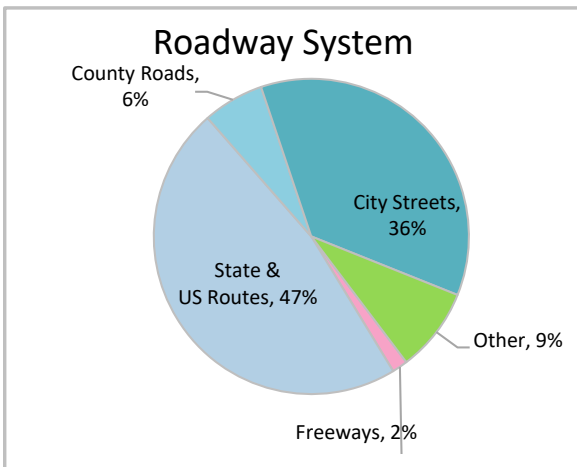
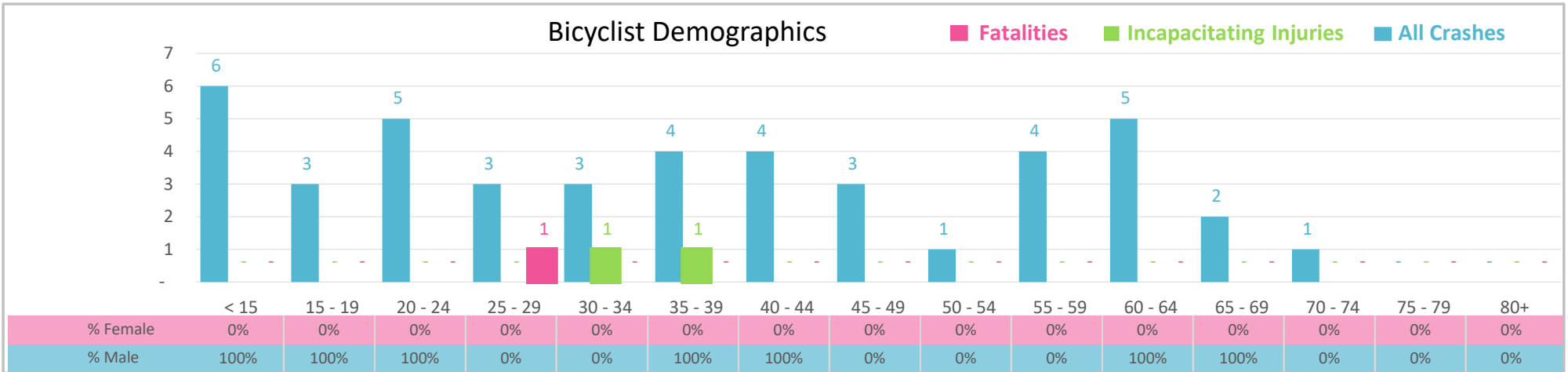

- ### Key Bicycle Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 279,238.
 - 39% of crashes involved cyclists under 30; male cyclists account for 62% of all crashes and 4 of 5 of fatal crashes.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 1 crash and resulted in 1 fatality crash.
 - 47% of crashes occurred along state and US routes with most of the remainder occurring on city streets.
 - Passenger cars accounted for 51% of the motor vehicles involved in bike crashes.
 - 3 of 5 fatalities occurred at night.
