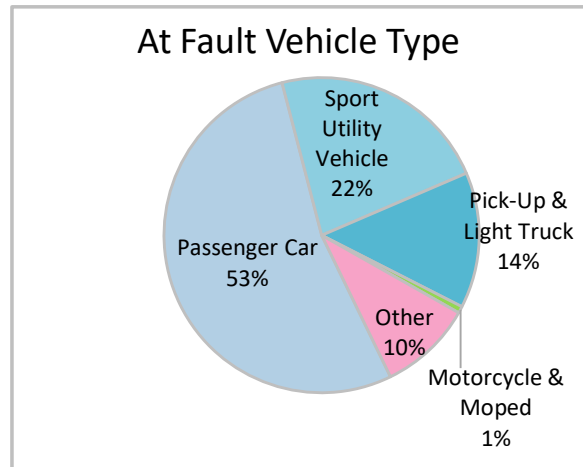
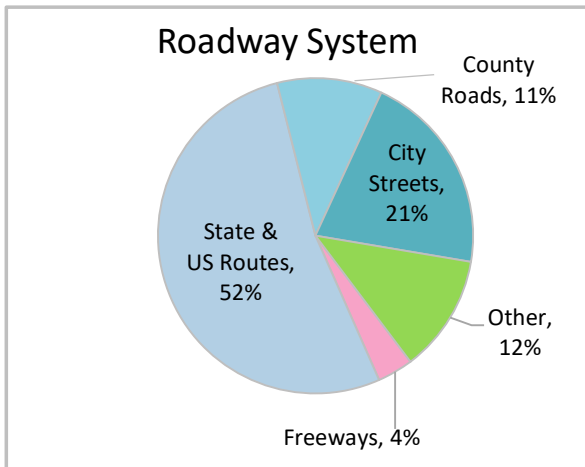
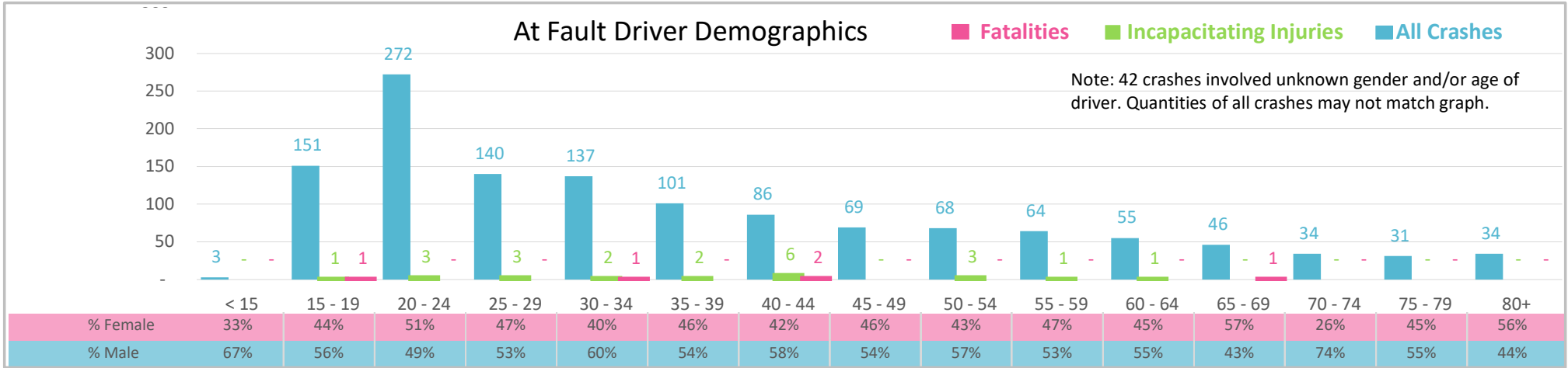

- ### Key Intersection Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 279,238.
  - 60% of crashes involved drivers under 40; male drivers account for 54% of all crashes and 4 of 5 of fatal crashes.
  - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 3% of crashes and resulted in 3 fatalities.
  - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 2% of crashes and resulted in 1 fatality.
  - 52% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on city streets.
  - Passenger cars accounted for 53% of motor vehicles involved in distracted driving crashes.
  - 22% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 2 fatal crashes.
