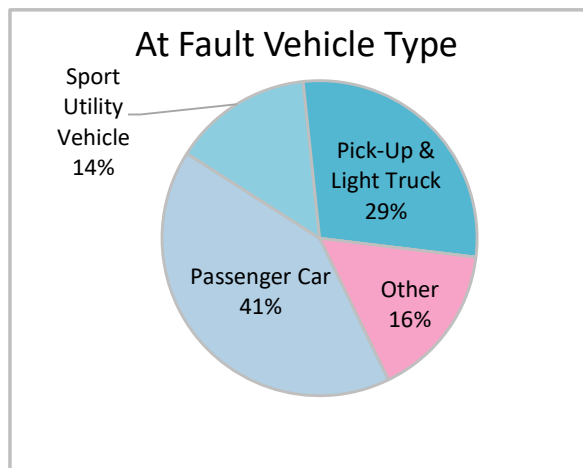
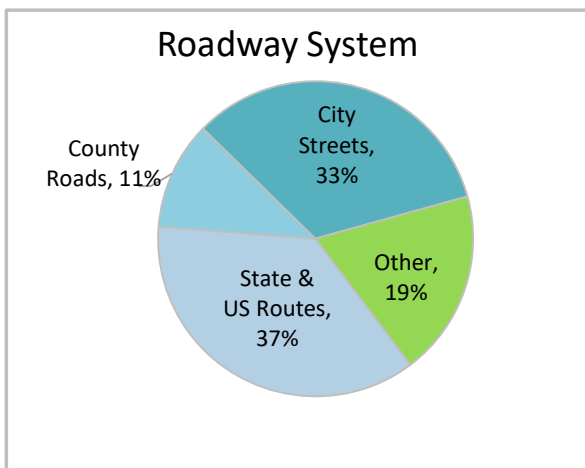
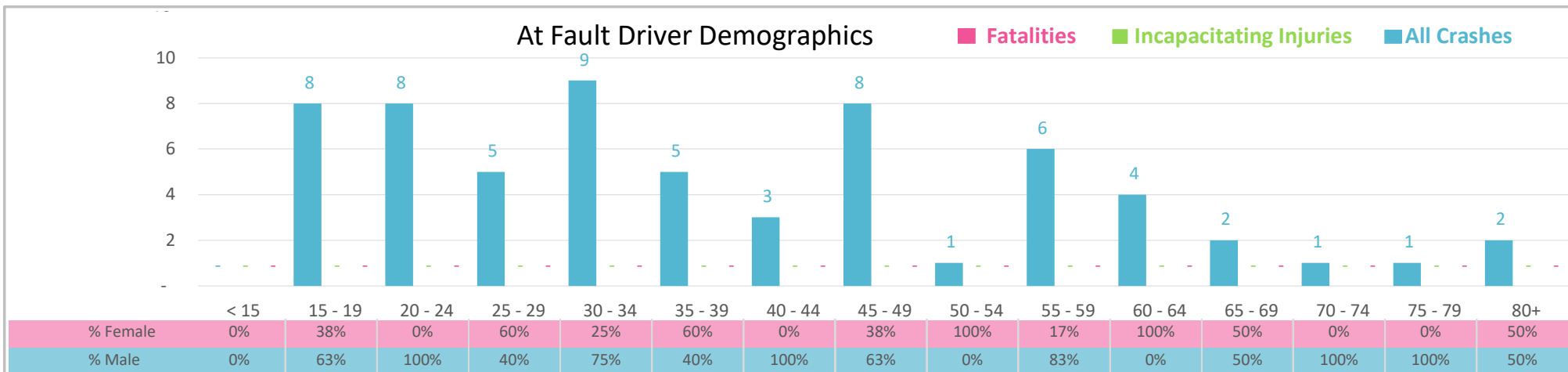

- ### Key Distracted Driving Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 28,540.
  - Driver age is distributed broadly across all age groups under 60; male drivers account for 65% of all crashes.
  - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 3 crashes.
  - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 2 crashes.
  - 37% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on city streets.
  - Passenger cars accounted for 41% of motor vehicles involved in distracted driving crashes.
  - 29% of crashes occurred at night.
