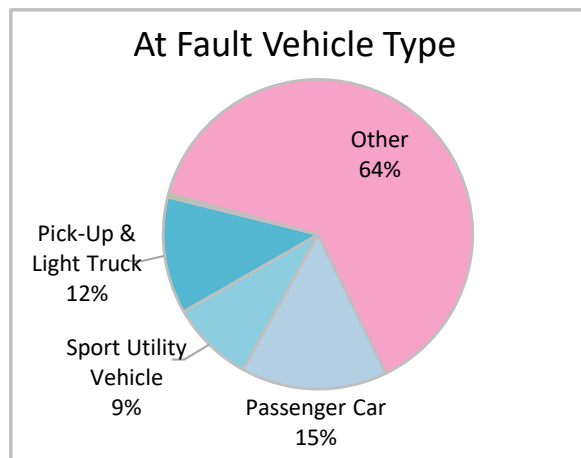
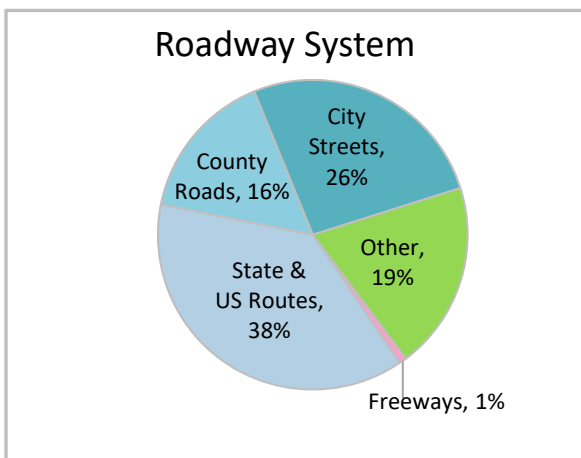
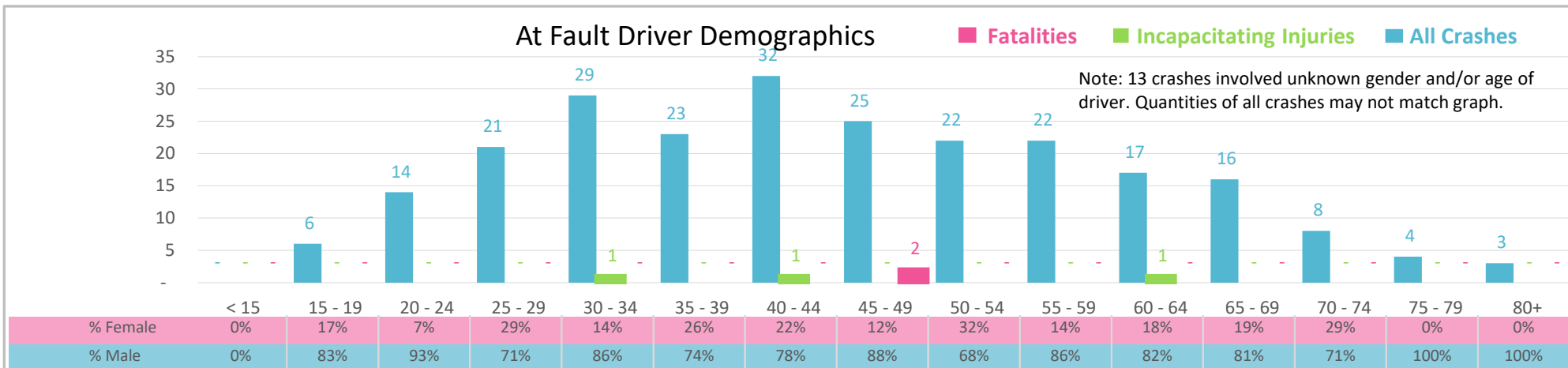

- ### Key Commercial Motor Vehicle Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 222,361.
 - Driver age is distributed broadly across all age groups under 70; male drivers account for 81% of all crashes and 2 fatalities.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 6 crashes.
 - Intoxication was not noted as a factor in any of the crashes.
 - 38% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on City Streets.
 - Other vehicle type accounted for 64% of motor vehicles involved in commercial vehicle crashes.
 - 19% of crashes occurred at night with 2 fatalities.
