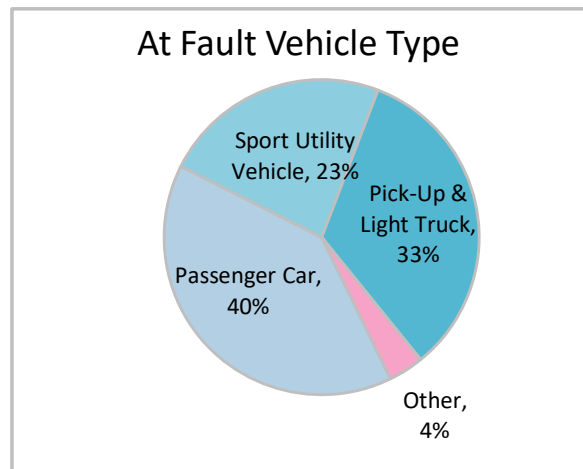
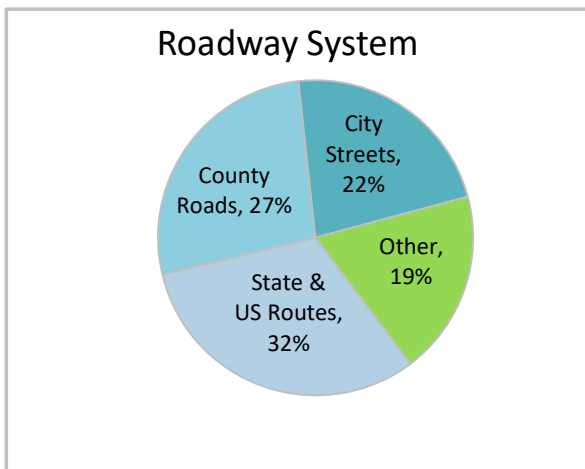
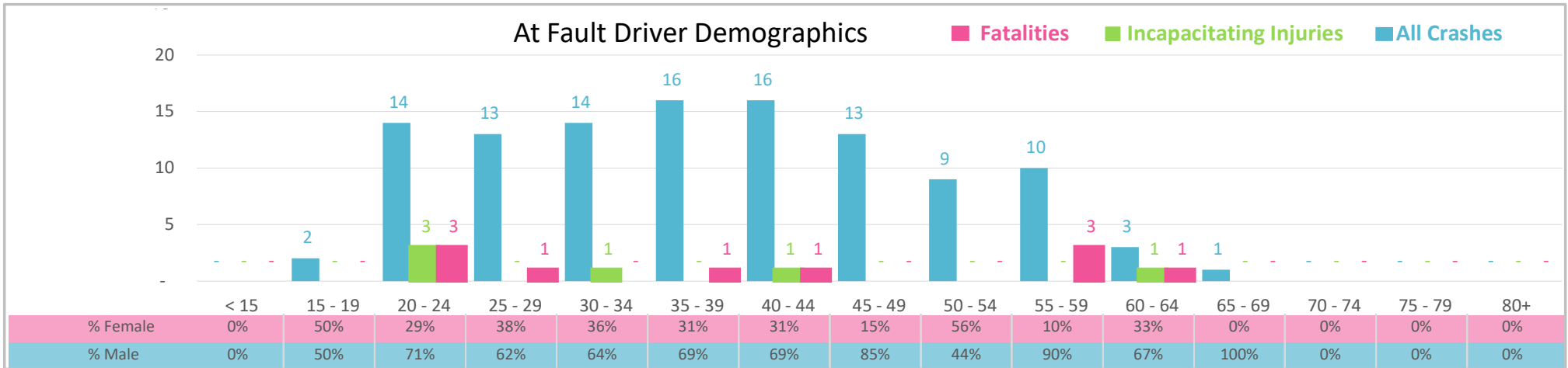

- ### Key Impaired Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 222,361.
 - Driver age is distributed broadly across all age groups under 50; male drivers account for 69% of all crashes and the 10 fatalities.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 19% crashes and resulted in 9 fatalities.
 - 32% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes and with most of the remainder occurring on County Roads.
 - Passenger cars accounted for 40% of motor vehicles involved in distracted driving crashes.
 - 64% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 5 fatalities.
