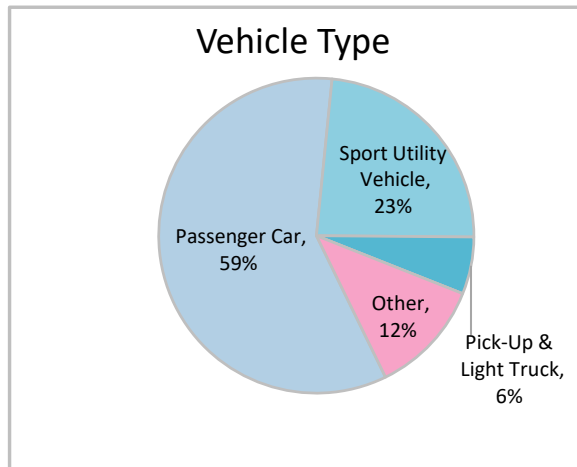
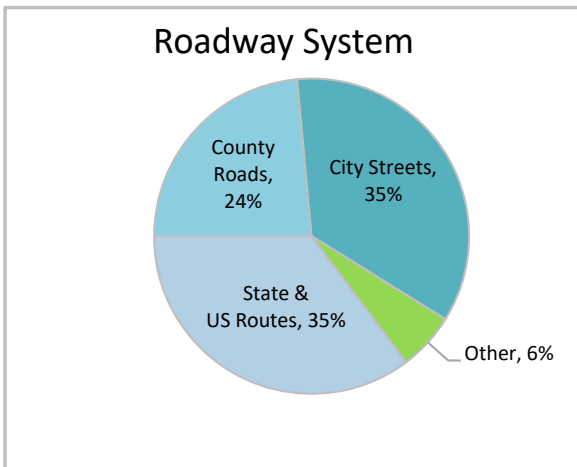
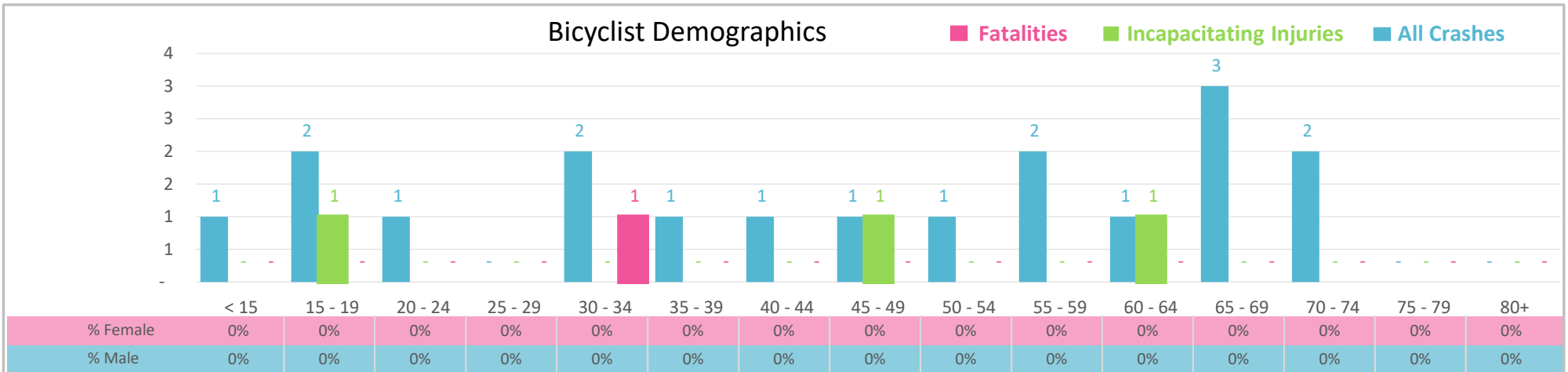

- ### Key Bicycle Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 70,385.
 - There was no pattern of crashes based on age; female cyclists account for 81% of all crashes and 2 of 3 of incapacitating injury crashes.
 - Intoxication resulted in the 1 fatal crash.
 - Roadway location of crashes were almost evenly distributed between state & US routes, county roads, and city streets with 35%, 24%, and 35%, respectively.
 - Passenger cars accounted for 59% of the motor vehicles involved in bike crashes.
 - Nighttime crashes accounted for the 1 fatality.
