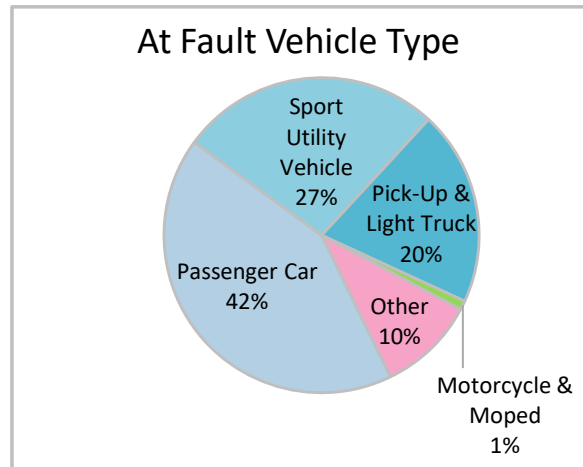
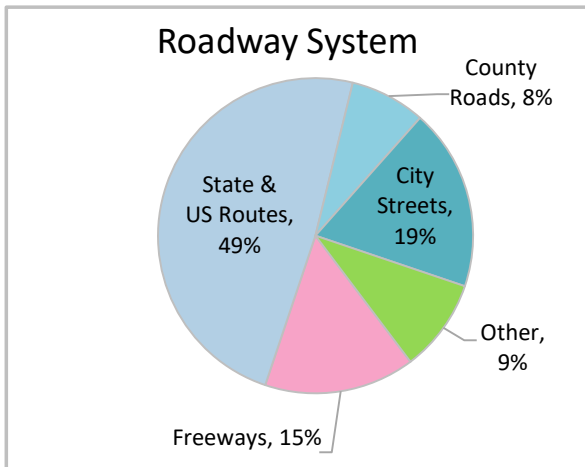
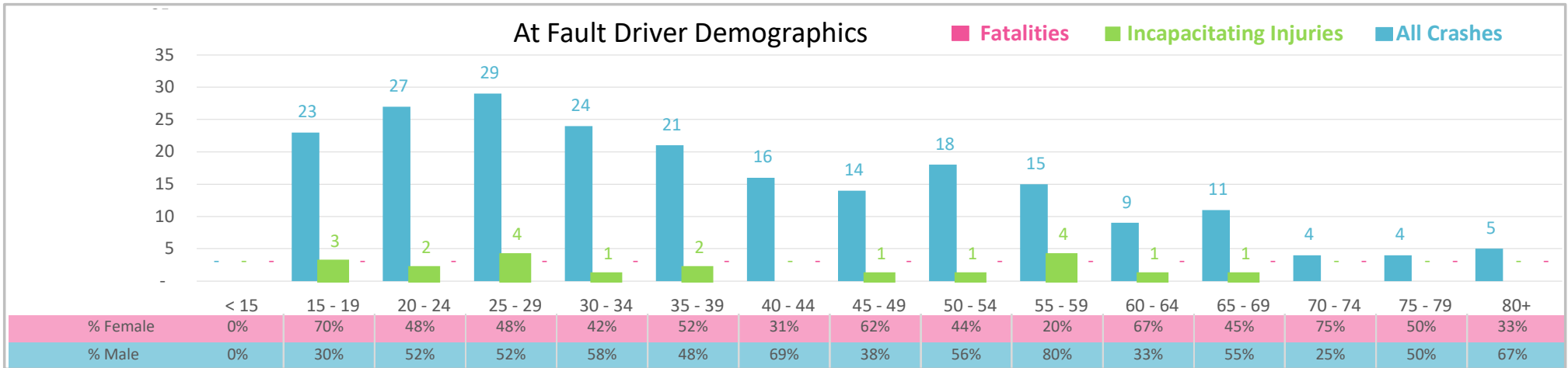

- ### Key Distracted Driving Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 70,385.
 - 47% of crashes involved drivers under 35; male drivers account for 51% of all crashes.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 7% of crashes.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 5% of crashes.
 - 49% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on city streets.
 - Passenger cars accounted for 42% of motor vehicles involved in distracted driving crashes.
 - 22% of crashes occurred at night.
