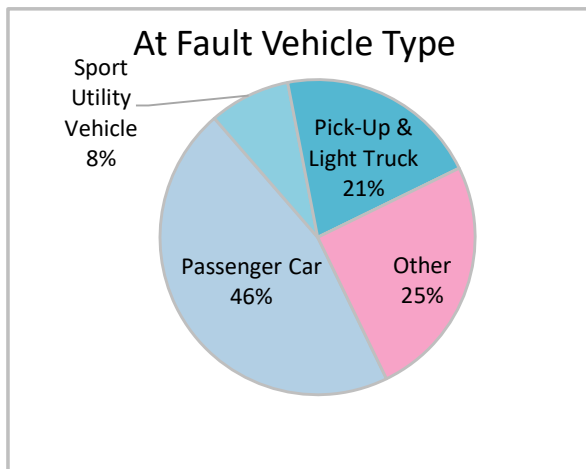
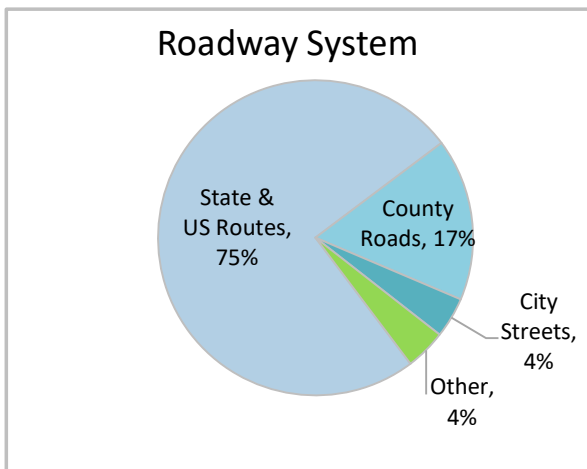
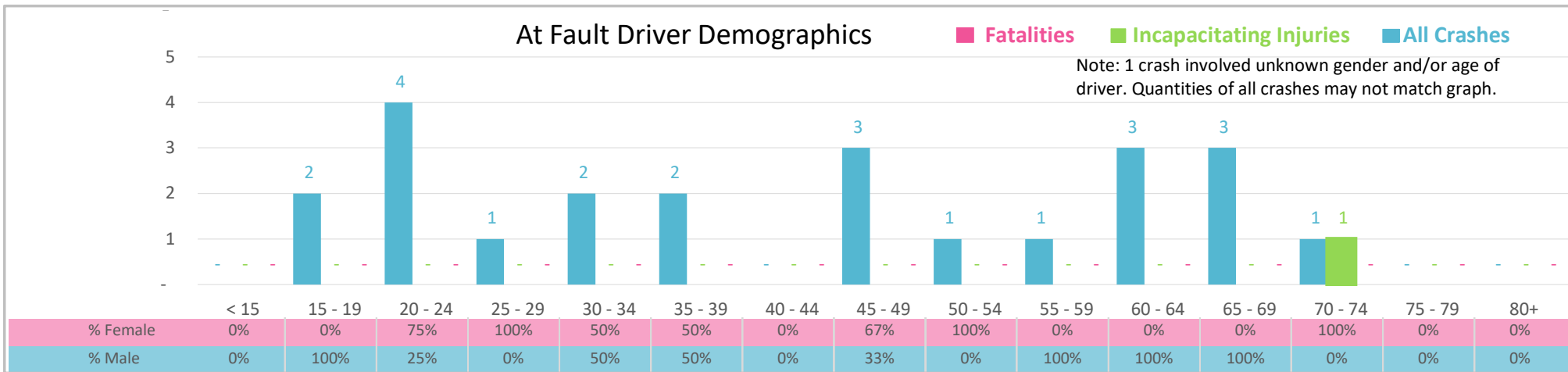

- ### Key Distracted Driving Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 17,102.
  - Driver age is distributed broadly across all age groups under 75; male drivers account for 57% of all crashes.
  - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 4 of 24 crashes.
  - Intoxication was not noted as a factor in any of crashes.
  - 75% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on county roads.
  - Passenger cars accounted for 46% of motor vehicles involved in distracted driving crashes.
  - 17% of crashes occurred at night.
