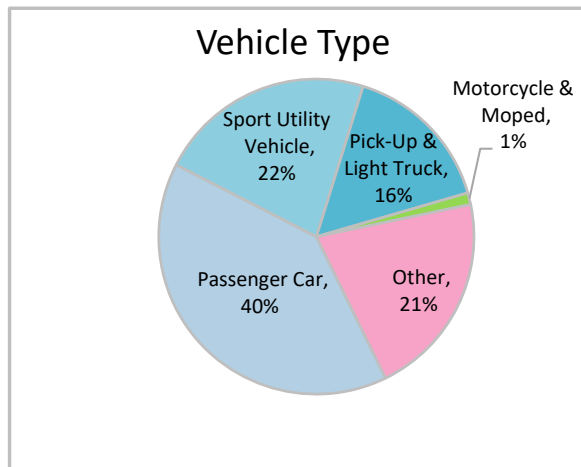
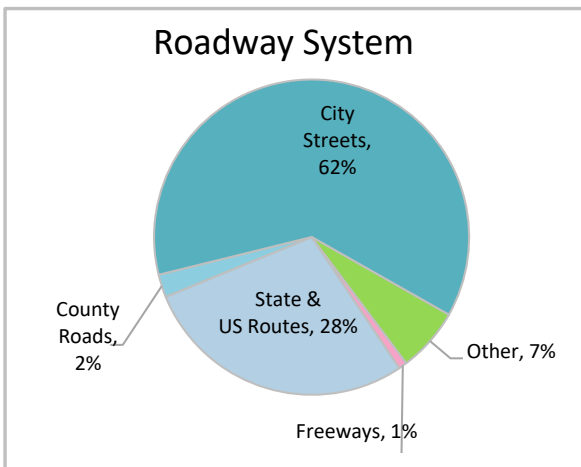
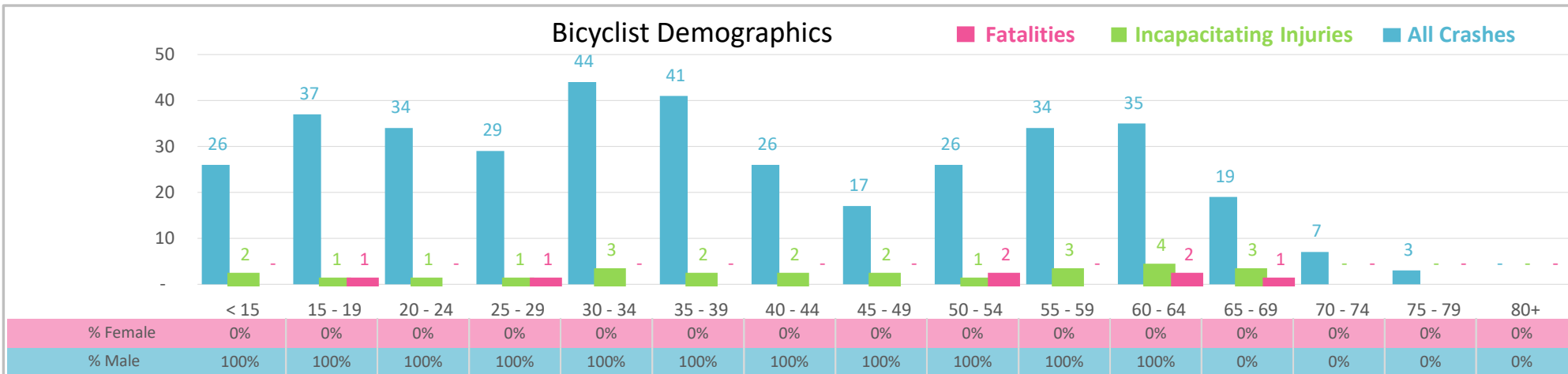

- ### Key Bicycle Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 999,935.
 - Cyclist age is distributed broadly across all age groups under 70; male cyclists account for 52% of all crashes and 4 of 6 of fatal crashes.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 1 crash.
 - 62% of crashes occurred along city streets with most of the remainder occurring on state & US routes.
 - Passenger cars accounted for 40% of the motor vehicles involved in bike crashes.
 - 4 of 6 fatalities occurred at night.
