



Key Impaired Crash Facts

- 2021 population of 999,935.
- 59% of crashes involved drivers under 40; male drivers account for 68% of all crashes and 37 fatalities.
- Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 12% of crashes and resulted in 53% of fatalities.
- 46% of crashes occurred along City Streets with most of the remainder occurring on State and US Routes.
- Passenger cars accounted for 52% of motor vehicles involved in distracted driving crashes.
- 70% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 82% of fatalities.
