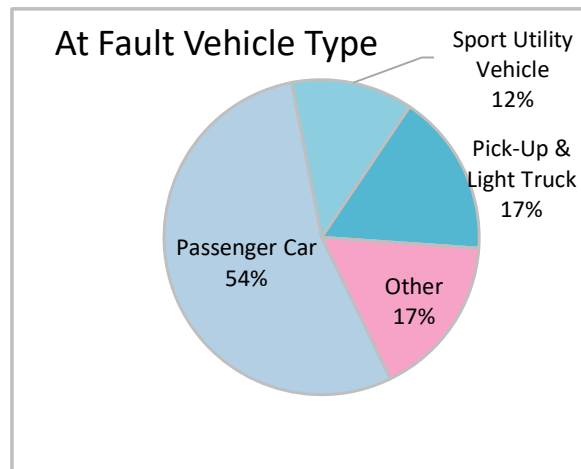
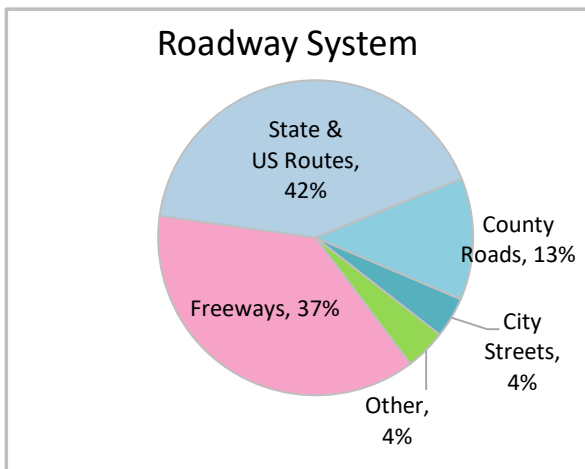
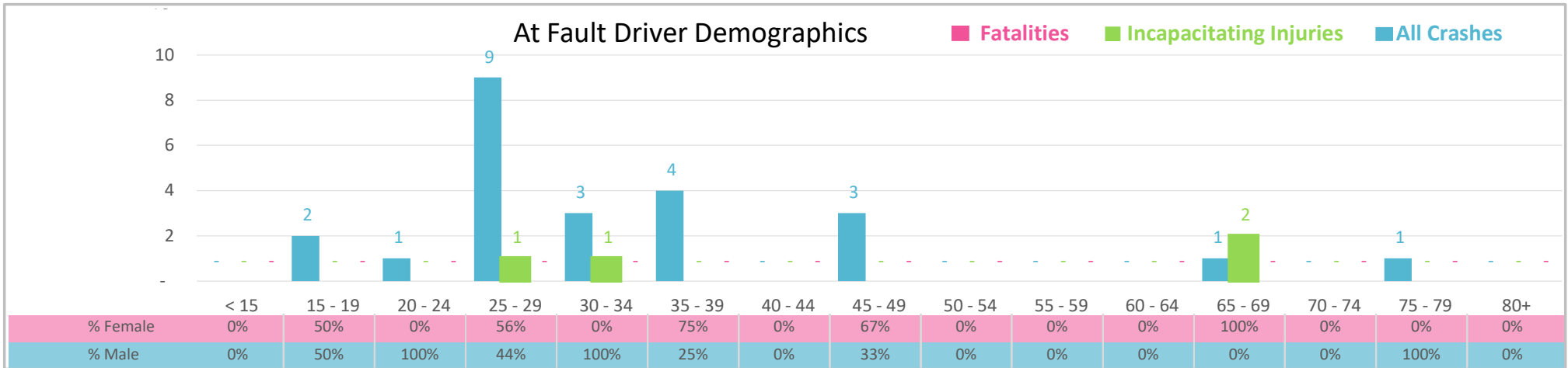

- ### Key Distracted Driving Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 13,993.
 - 50% of crashes involved drivers under 30; male and female drivers equally accounted for all crashes.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 2 of 24 crashes.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 1 of 24 crashes.
 - 42% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on freeways.
 - Passenger cars accounted for 54% of motor vehicles involved in distracted driving crashes.
 - 38% of crashes occurred at night.
