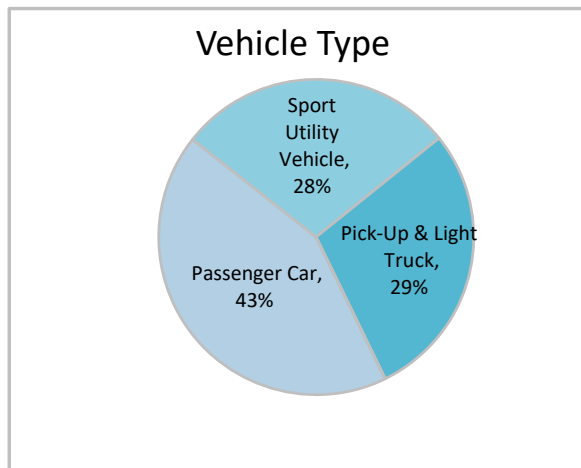
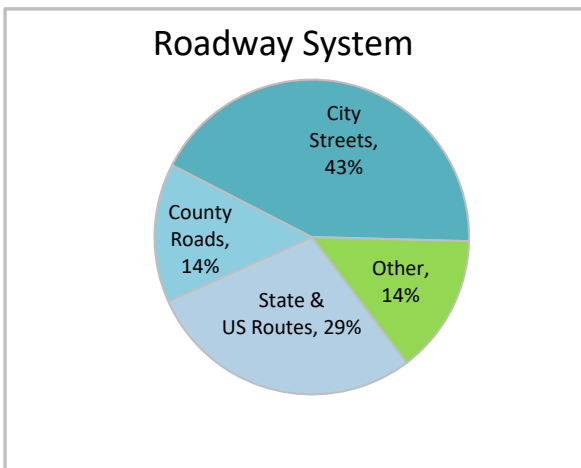
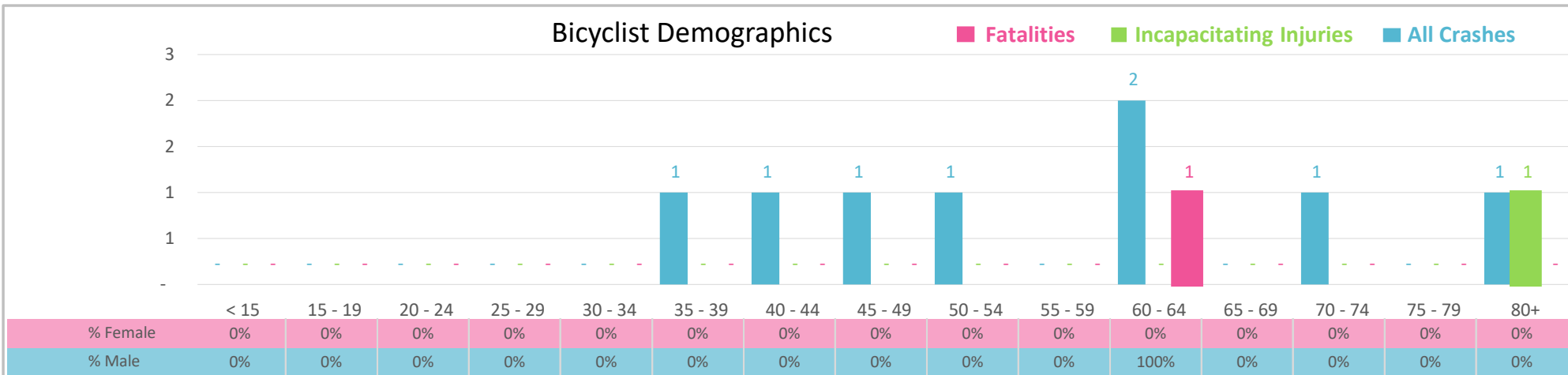

- ### Key Bicycle Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 44,158.
  - Male cyclists account for 4 of 7 crashes and for the 1 fatal crash.
  - Intoxication was not noted as a factor in any of crashes.
  - 3 of 7 crashes occurred along city streets.
  - Passenger cars accounted for 3 of 7 of the motor vehicles involved in bike crashes.
  - Nighttime crashes accounted for the 1 fatal crash.
