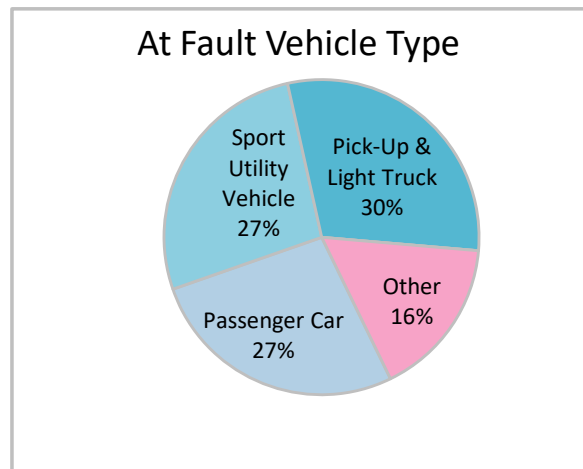
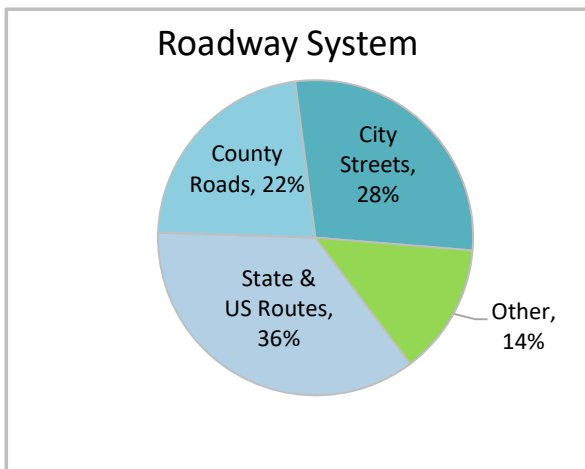
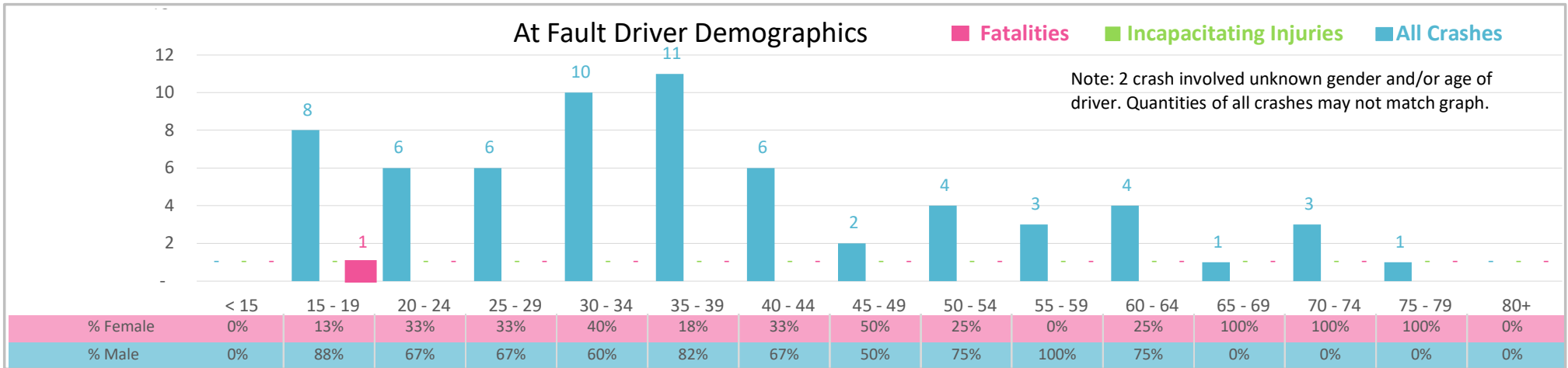

- ### Key Distracted Driving Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 44,158.
  - 45% of crashes involved drivers under 35; male drivers account for 68% of all crashes and the 1 fatal crash.
  - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 7 crashes.
  - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 6 crashes.
  - 36% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on city streets.
  - Types of motor vehicles involved in distracted driving crashes were generally equally distributed with highest involving pick-up and light trucks, 30%.
  - 37% of crashes occurred at night.
