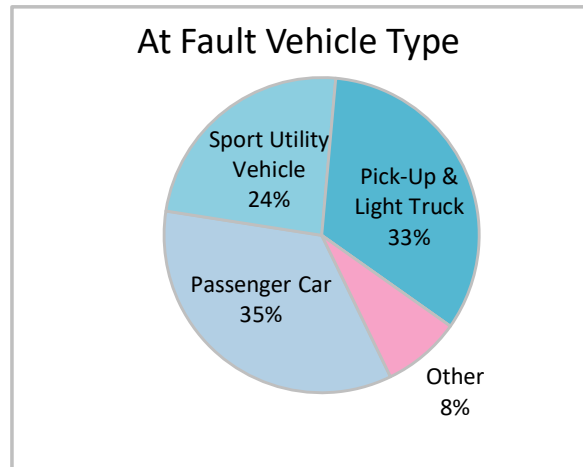
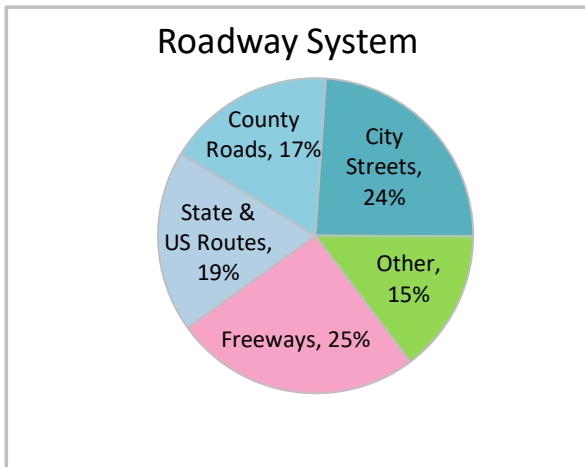
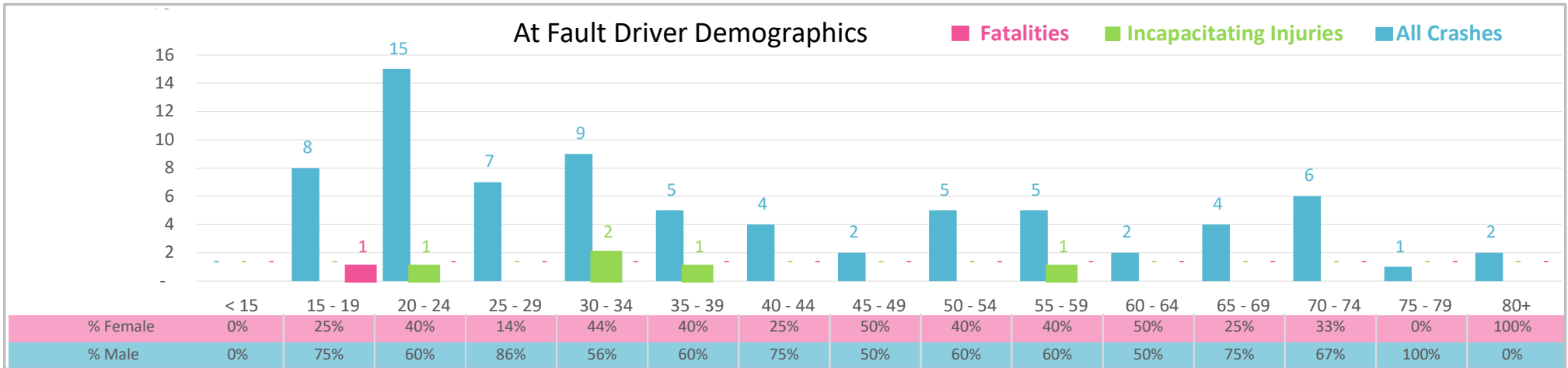

*NOTE: Crash severity is determined from the highest injury type in the crash (i.e. if a crash had both a fatal and a serious it is determined to be a fatal crash).



- ### Key Distracted Driving Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 18,288.
 - 52% of crashes involved drivers under 35; male drivers account for 64% of all crashes and the 1 fatal crash.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 19% of crashes.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 4 crashes.
 - Crashes occurred mostly distributed along all roadway systems with highest on Freeways, 25%.
 - Types of motor vehicles involved in distracted driving crashes were generally equally distributed with highest involving passenger cars, 35%.
 - 22% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 2 fatal crashes.
