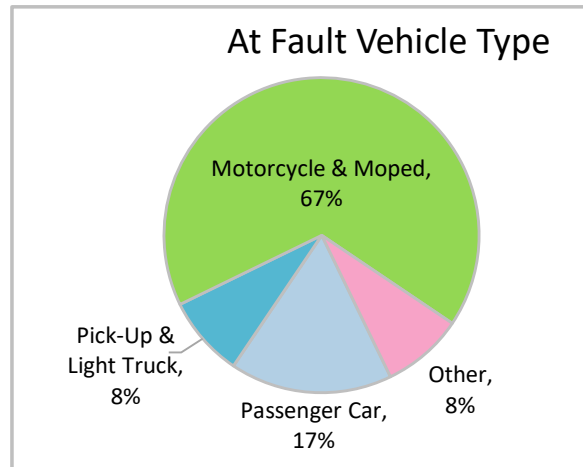
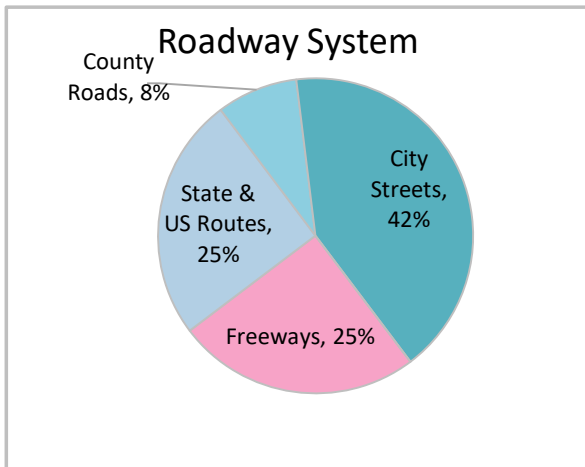
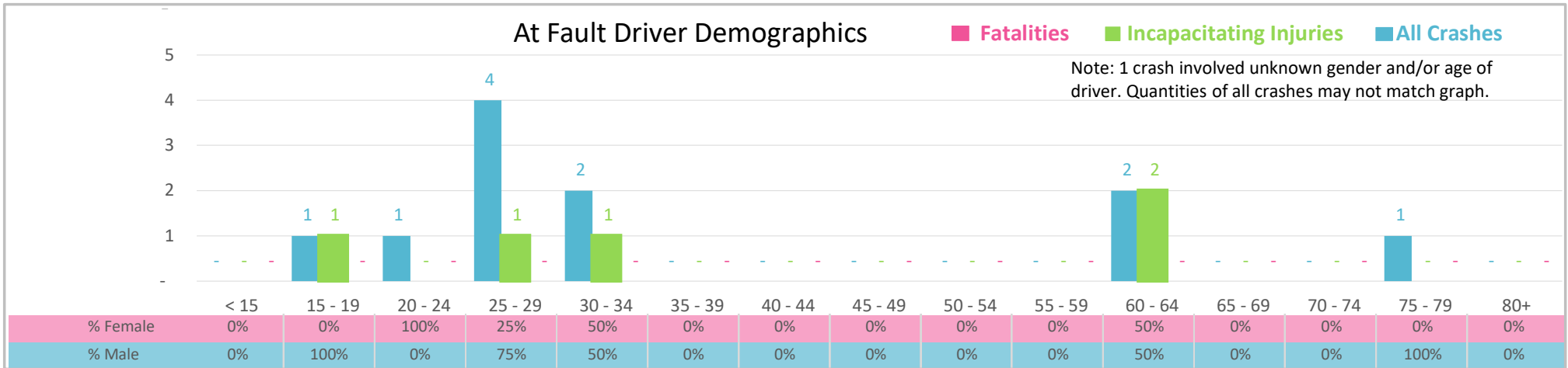

- ### Key Motorcycle Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 18,288.
 - Driver age is distributed broadly across all age groups; male drivers account for 64% of all crashes.
 - Unrestrained occupant was not noted as a factor in crashes.
 - Intoxication was not noted as a factor in crashes.
 - 42% of crashes occurred along City Streets with most of the remainder occurring on state and US Routes and Freeways.
 - Motorcycles and mopeds accounted for 67% of at fault motor vehicles involved in motorcycle crashes.
 - 3 crashes occurred at night.
