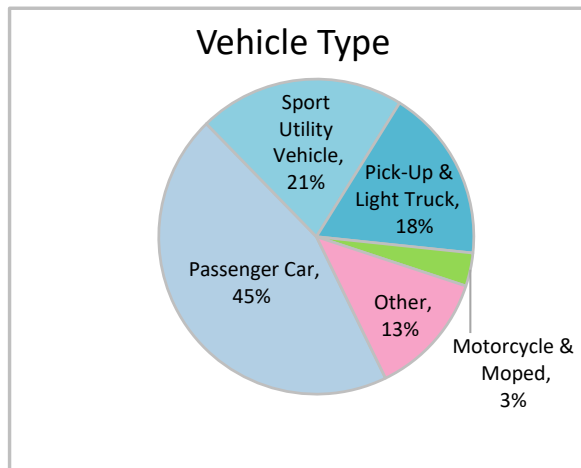
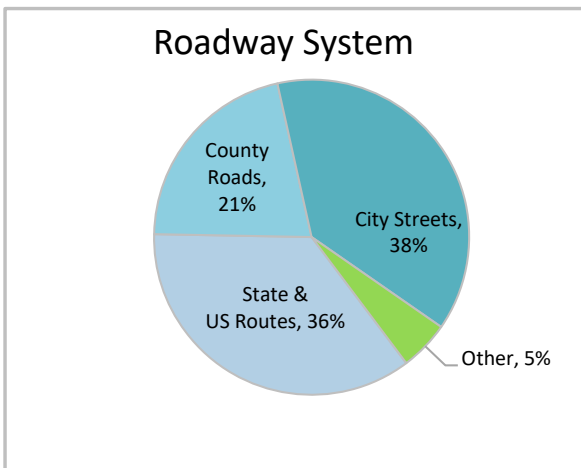
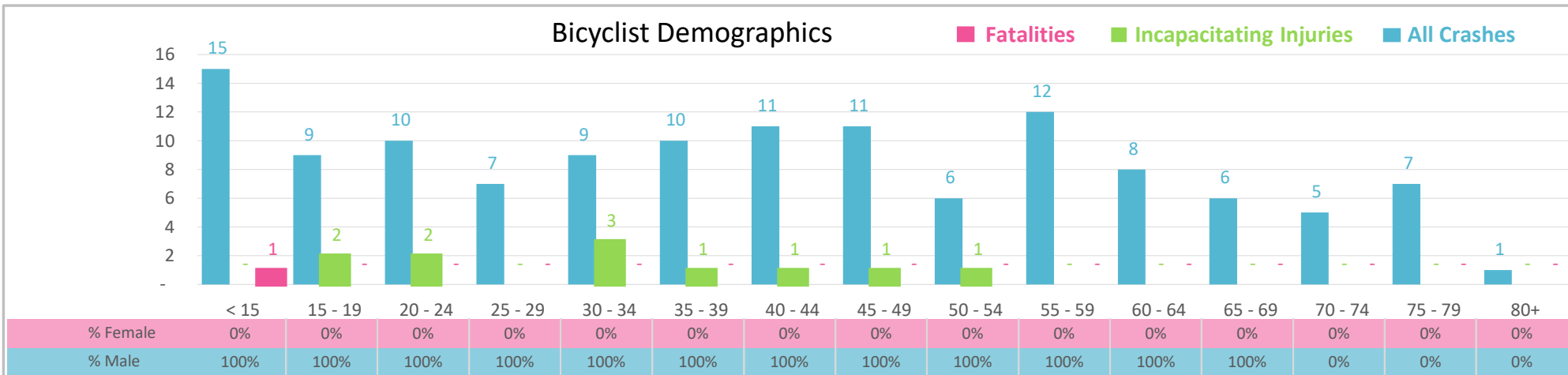

- ### Key Bicycle Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 292,466.
 - 39% of crashes involved cyclists under 35; male cyclists account for 53% of all crashes with the 1 fatality and 4 of 9 of incapacitating injury crashes.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 1 crash and resulted in the 1 fatal crash.
 - 38% of crashes occurred along city streets with most of the remainder occurring on state and US routes .
 - Passenger cars accounted for 45% of the motor vehicles involved in bike crashes.
 - Nighttime crashes accounted for the 1 fatality.
