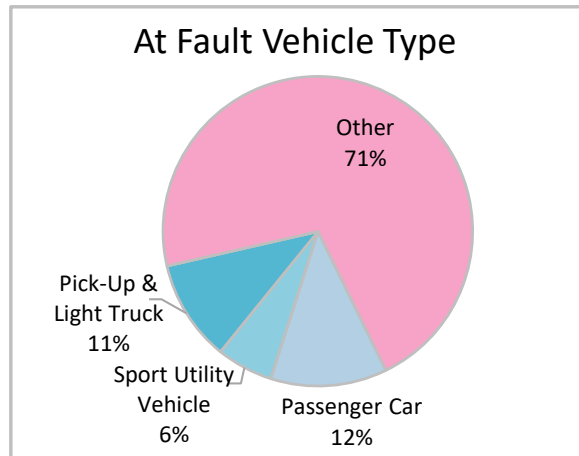
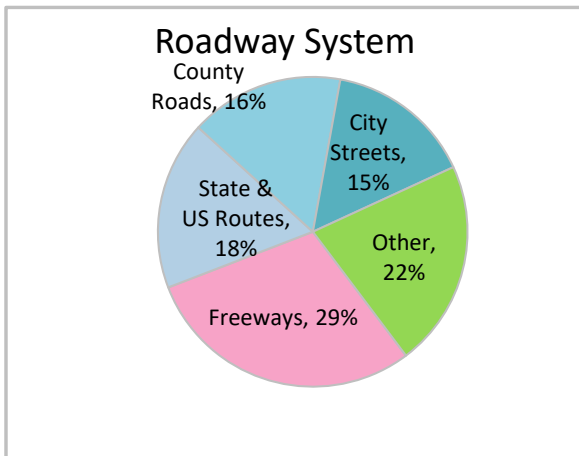
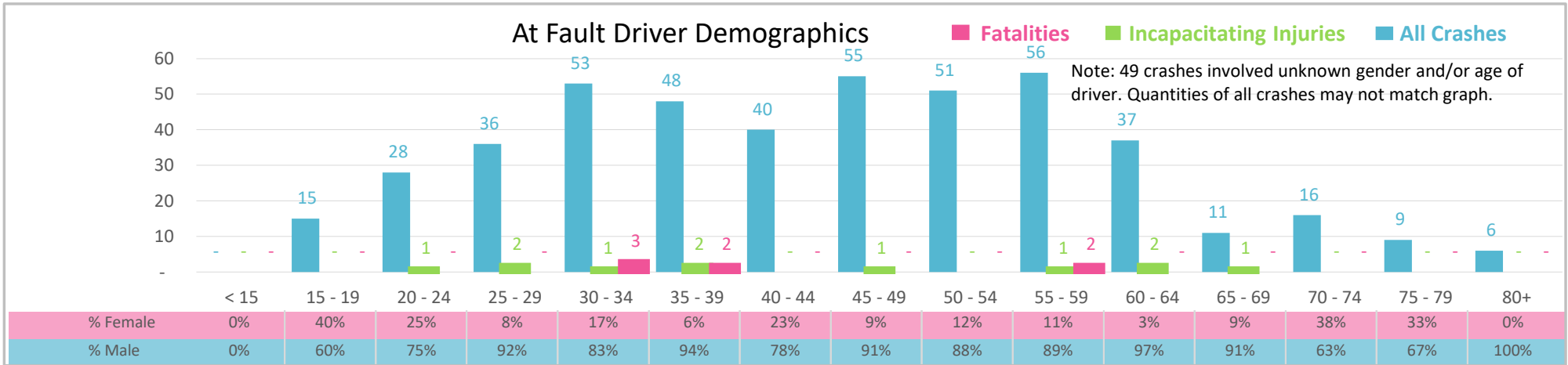

- ### Key Commercial Motor Vehicle Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 292,466.
  - Driver age is distributed broadly across all age groups under 65; male drivers account for 85% of all crashes and 6 fatalities.
  - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 4% of crashes and resulted in 5 fatalities.
  - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 7 crashes and resulted in 3 fatalities.
  - 29% of crashes occurred along Freeways with most of the remainder occurring on Other roadway systems.
  - Other vehicle type accounted for 71% of motor vehicles involved in commercial vehicle crashes.
  - 25% of crashes occurred at night with 4 fatalities.
