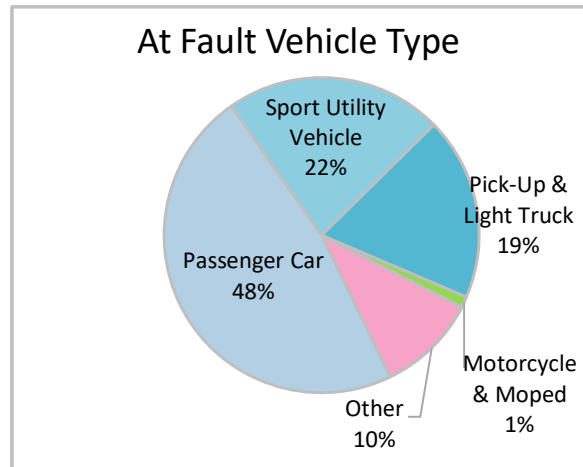
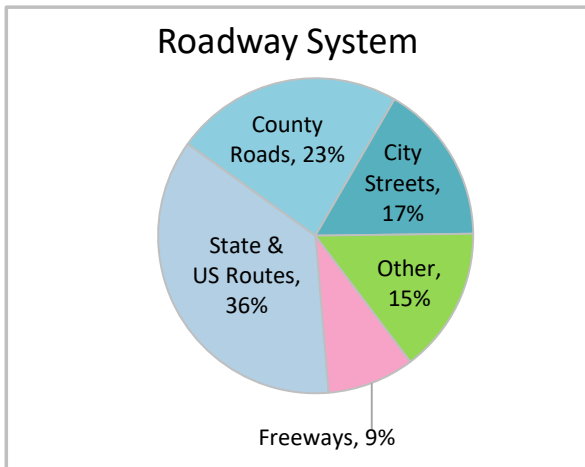
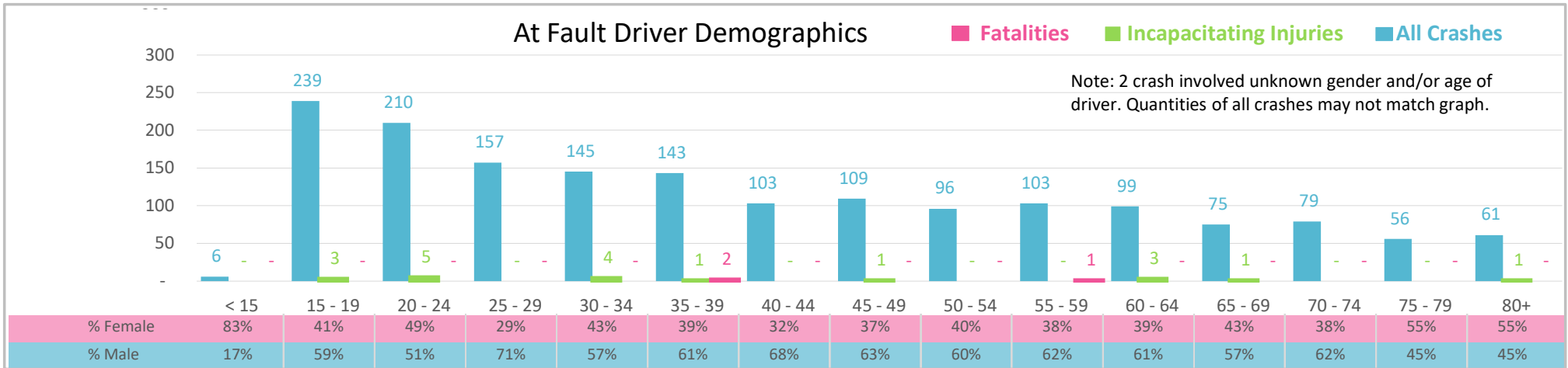

- ### Key Distracted Driving Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 292,466.
  - 45% of crashes involved drivers under 35; male drivers account for 59% of all crashes and 2 of 3 fatal crashes.
  - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 3% of crashes and resulted in 1 fatality.
  - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 4% of crashes.
  - 36% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on county roads.
  - Passenger cars accounted for 48% of motor vehicles involved in distracted driving crashes.
  - 19% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 2 of 3 fatal crashes.
