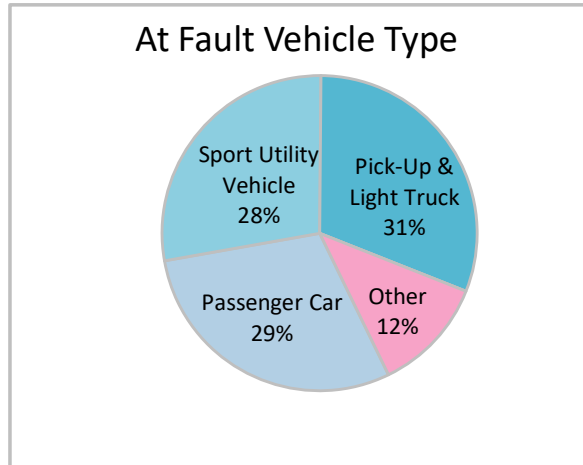
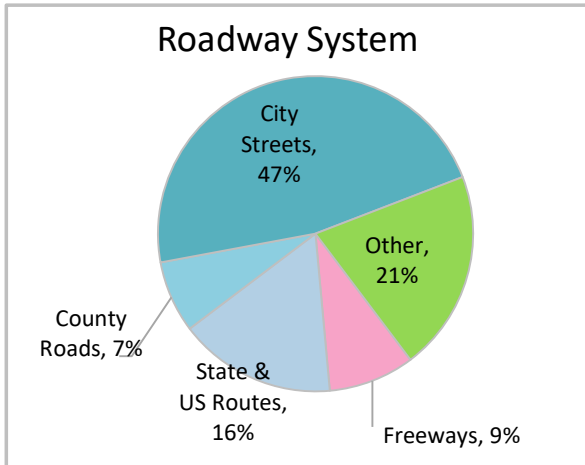
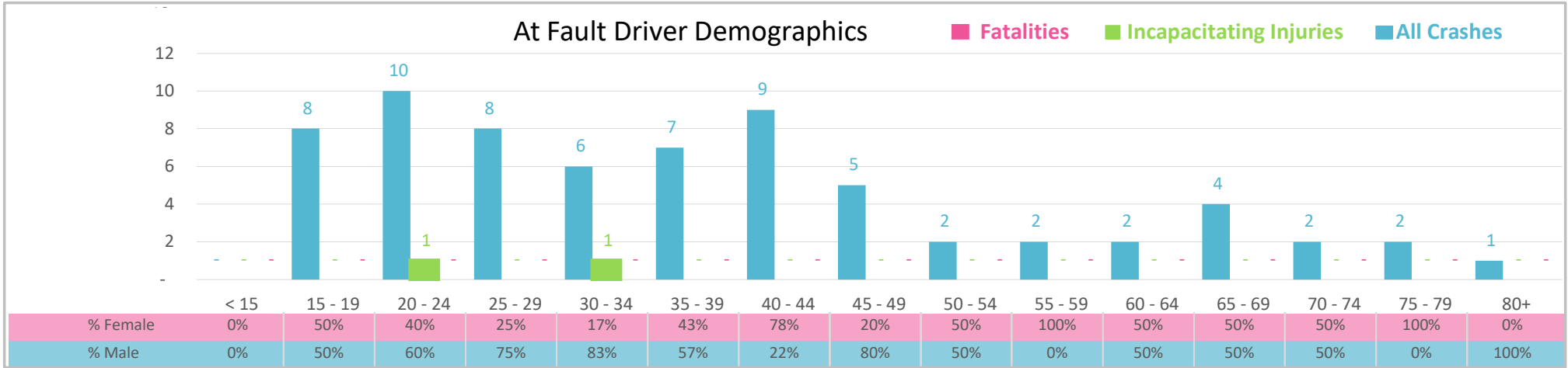

- ### Key Distracted Driving Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 44,485.
  - 47% of crashes involved drivers under 35; male drivers account for 54% of all crashes.
  - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 4 crashes.
  - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 4 crashes.
  - 47% of crashes occurred along City Streets with most of the remainder occurring on Other road systems.
  - Types of motor vehicles involved in distracted driving crashes were generally equally distributed with highest involving pick-up and light trucks, 31%.
  - 21% of crashes occurred at night.
