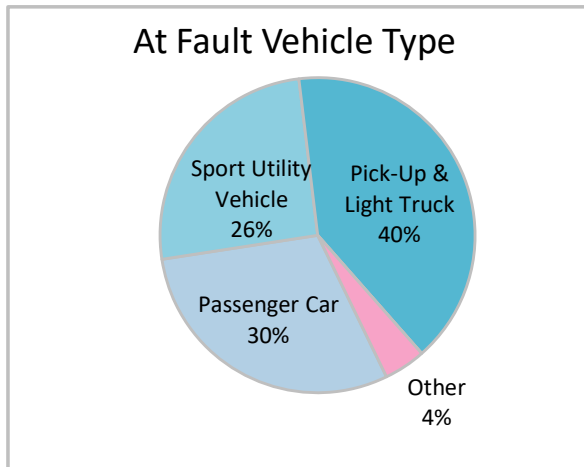
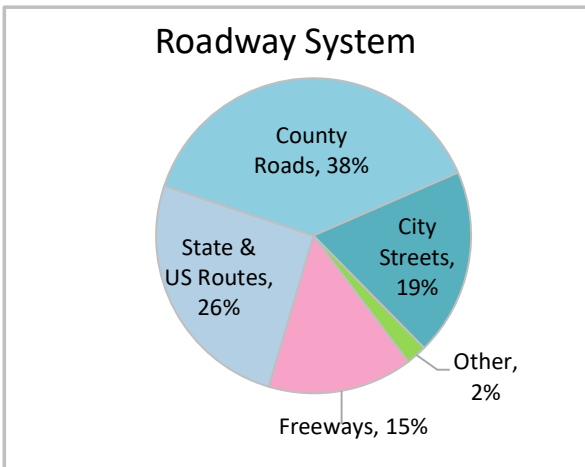
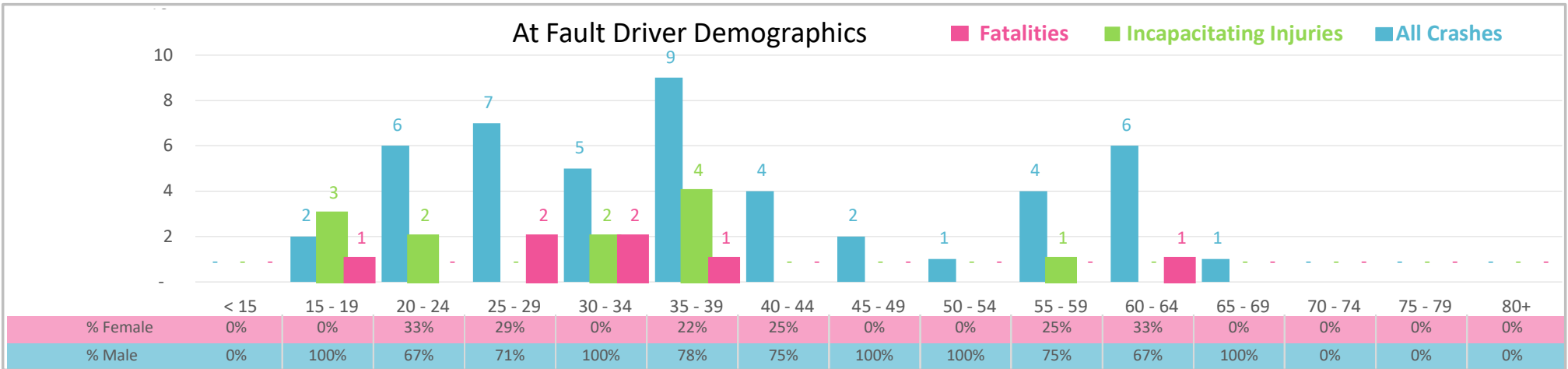

- ### Key Impaired Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 44,485.
  - Driver age is distributed broadly across all age groups under 65; male drivers account for 79% of all crashes and all 7 fatalities.
  - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 26% of crashes and resulted in 4 fatalities.
  - 38% of crashes occurred along County Roads with most of the remainder occurring on State and US Routes.
  - Pick-up and light trucks accounted for 40% of motor vehicles involved in distracted driving crashes
  - 81% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 5 fatalities.
