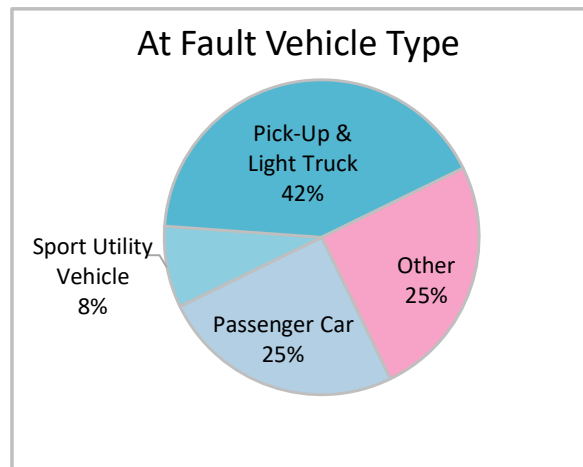
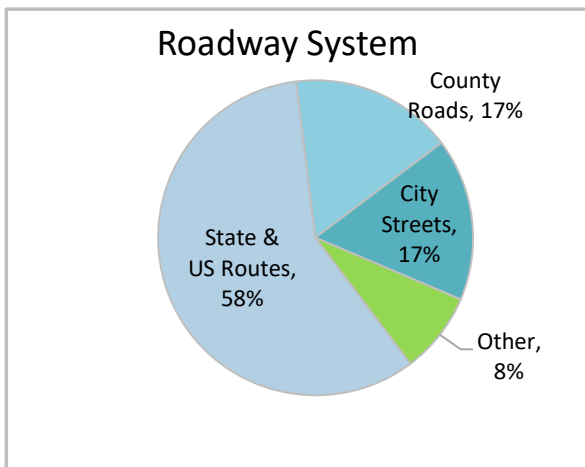
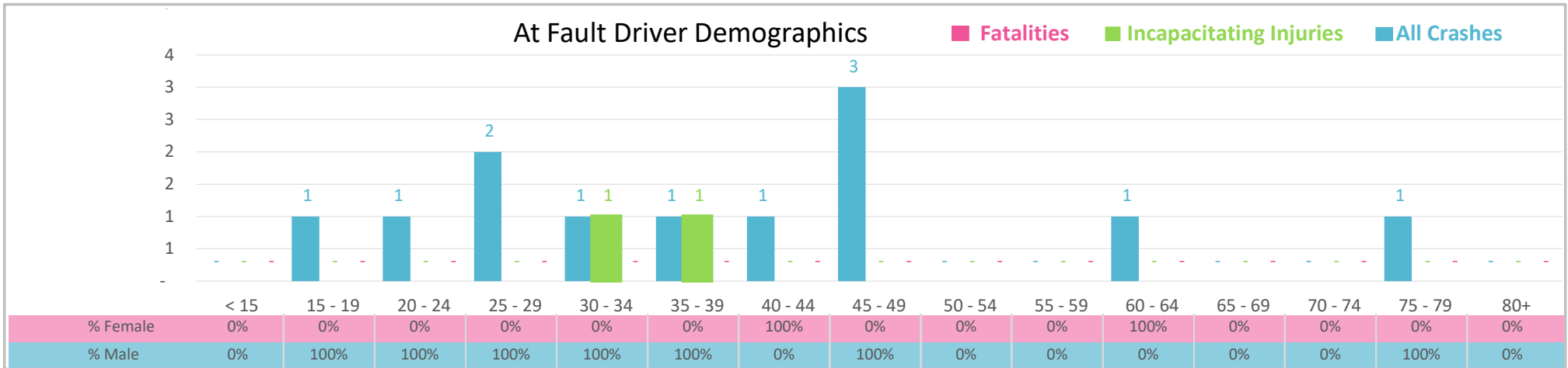

- ### Key Distracted Driving Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 16,335.
  - Driver age is distributed broadly across all age groups under 50; male drivers account for 83% of all crashes.
  - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 1 crash.
  - Intoxication was not noted as a factor in any of crashes.
  - 58% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on City Streets and County Roads.
  - Pick-up and light trucks accounted for 42% of motor vehicles involved in distracted driving crashes.
  - 6 of 12 crashes occurred at night.
