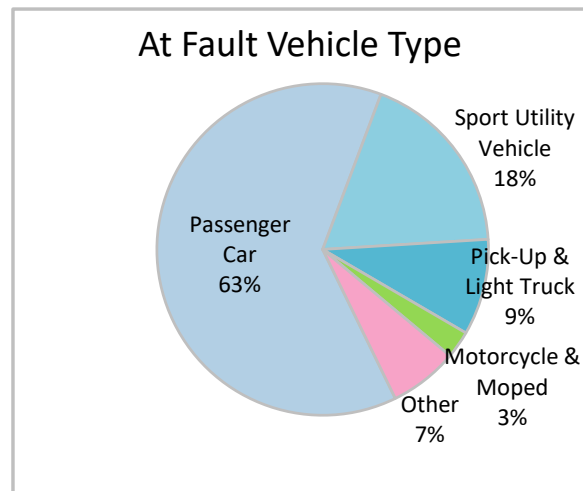
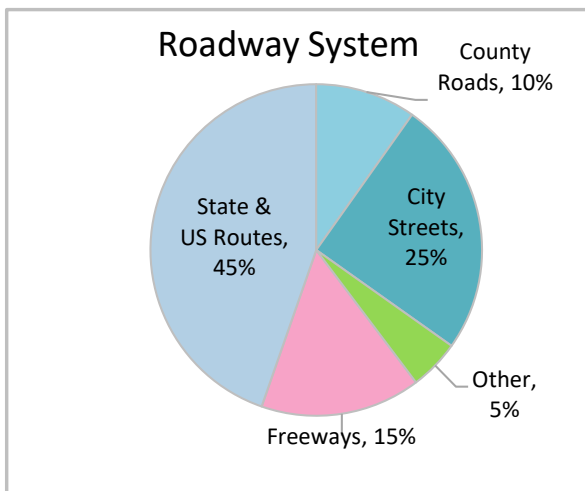
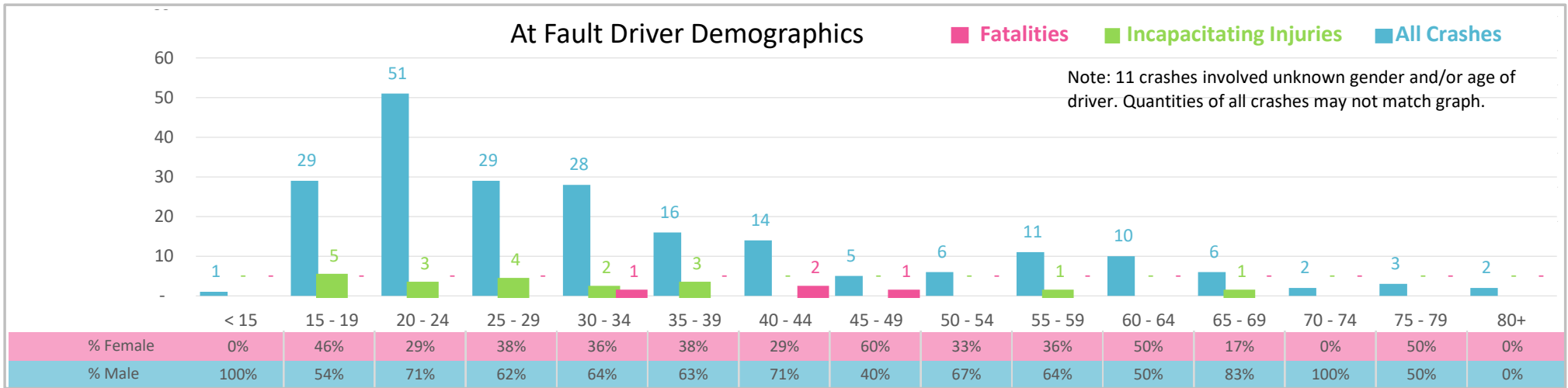

- ### Key Aggressive Driving Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 279,238.
 - 62% of crashes involved drivers under 35; male drivers account for 64% of all crashes and 4 fatalities.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 10% of crashes and resulted in 3 fatalities.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 11% of crashes and resulted in 3 fatalities.
 - 45% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on City Streets.
 - Passenger car accounted for 63% of motor vehicles involved in aggressive driving crashes.
 - 37% of crashes occurred at night with 1 fatality.
