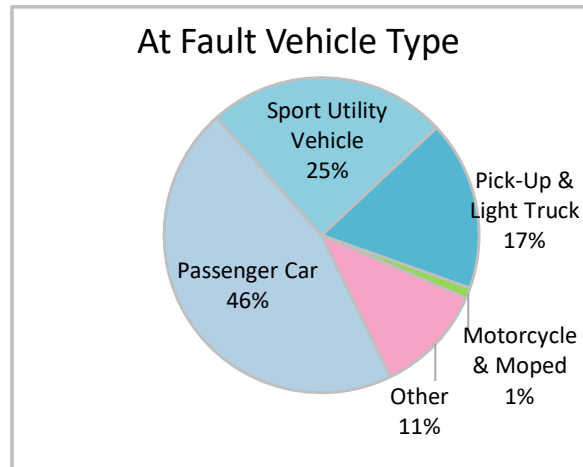
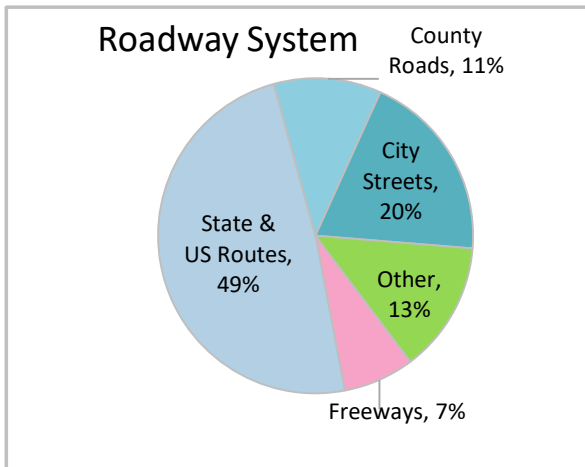
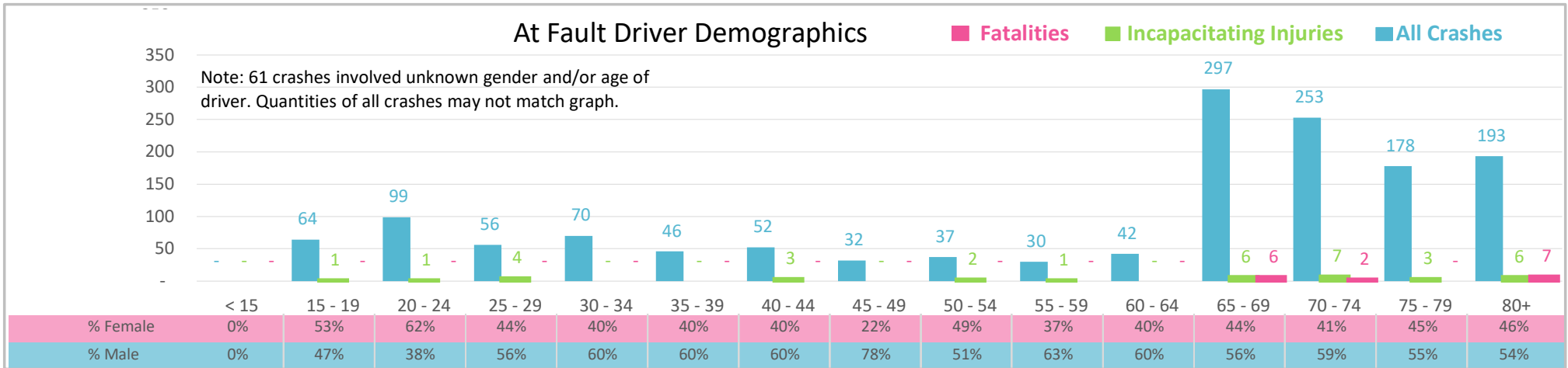

- ### Key Aging Road User Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 279,238.
 - 61% of crashes caused by drivers 65 and older; male drivers account for 56% of all crashes and 6 fatalities.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 2% of crashes and resulted in 3 fatalities.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 1% of crashes and resulted in 1 fatality.
 - 49% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on City Streets.
 - Passenger car accounted for 46% of motor vehicles involved in aging driver crashes.
 - 14% of crashes occurred at night with 7 fatalities.
