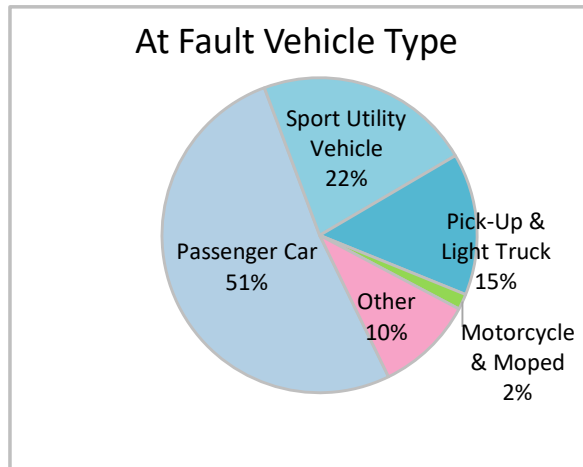
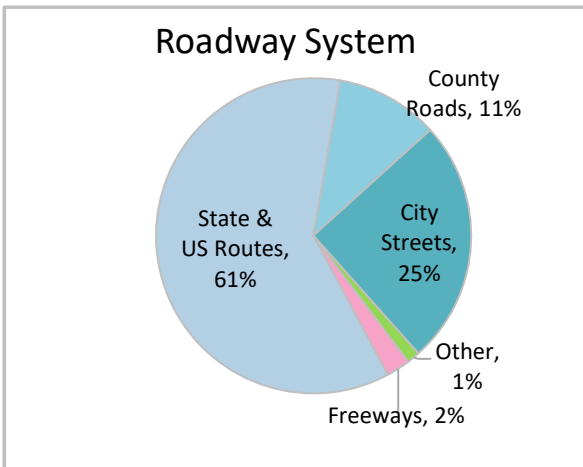
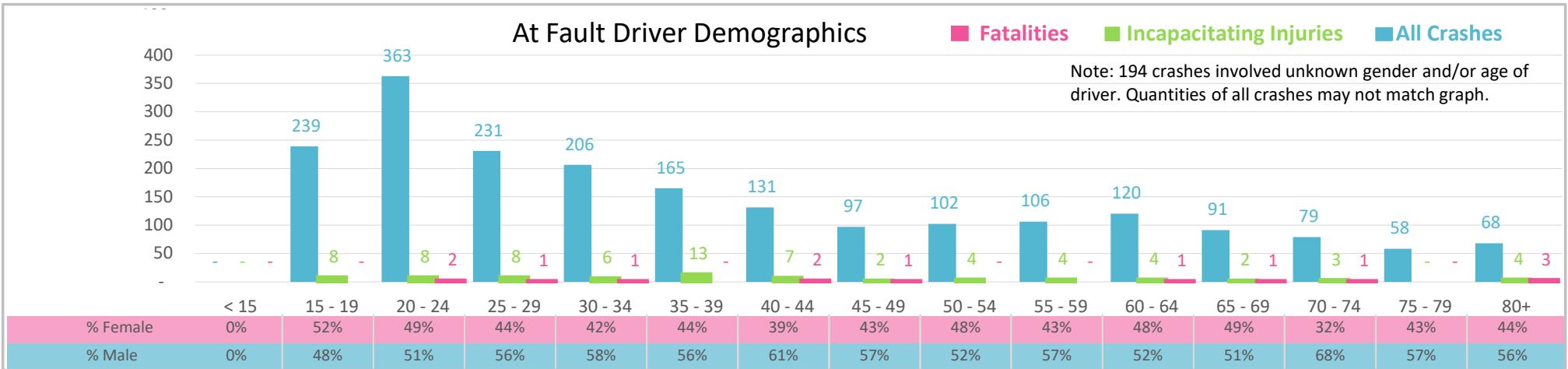

- ### Key Intersection Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 279,238.
  - 54% of crashes caused by drivers under 40; male drivers account for 55% of all crashes and 6 fatalities.
  - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 3% of crashes and resulted in 1 fatality.
  - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 2% of crashes and resulted in 3 fatalities.
  - 61% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on City Streets.
  - Passenger car accounted for 51% of motor vehicles involved in intersection crashes.
  - 25% of crashes occurred at night with 4 fatalities.
