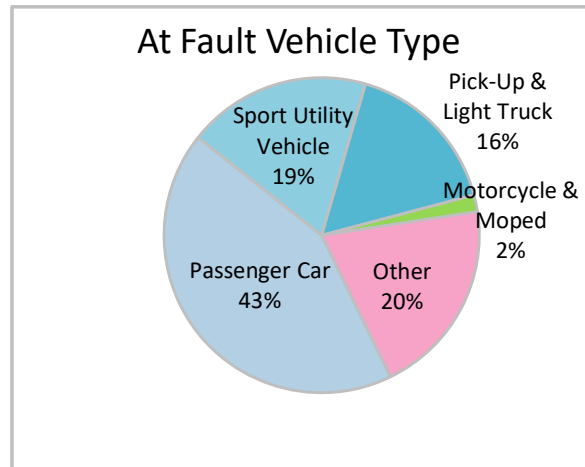
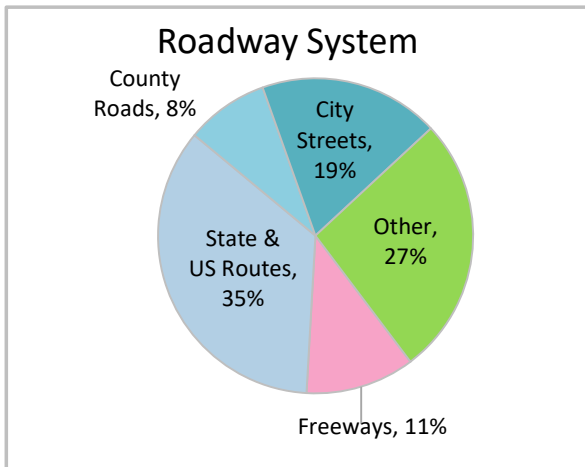
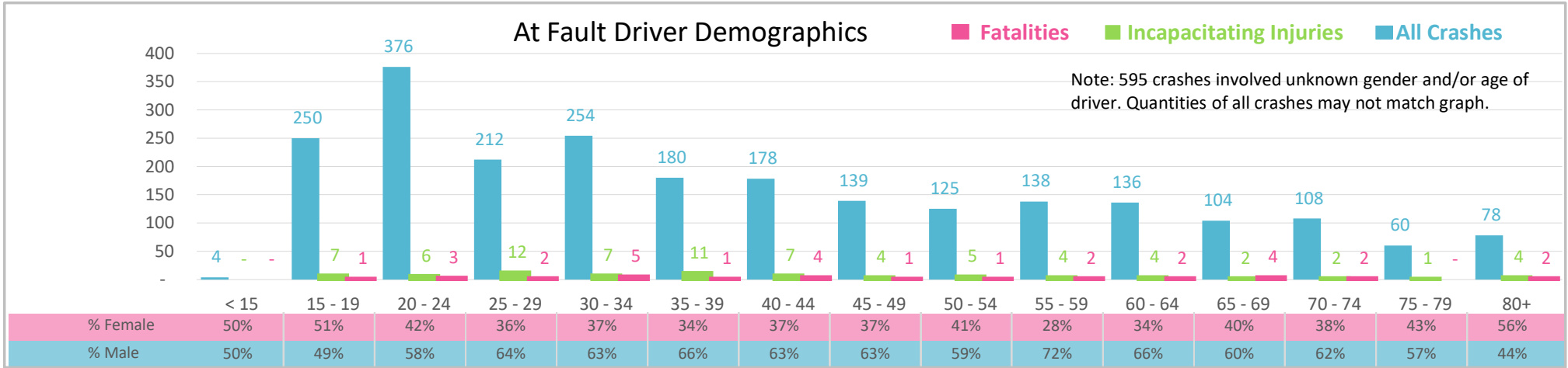

- ### Key Lane Departure Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 279,238.
 - 43% of crashes involved drivers under 40; male drivers account for 61% of all crashes and 84% of fatalities.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 4% of crashes and resulted in 50% of fatalities.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 5% of crashes and resulted in 6 fatalities.
 - 35% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on Other roadway systems.
 - Passenger car accounted for 43% of motor vehicles involved in lane departure crashes.
 - 32% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 10 fatalities.
