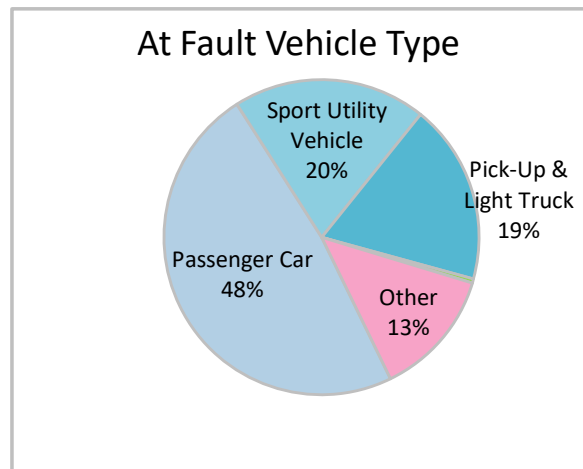
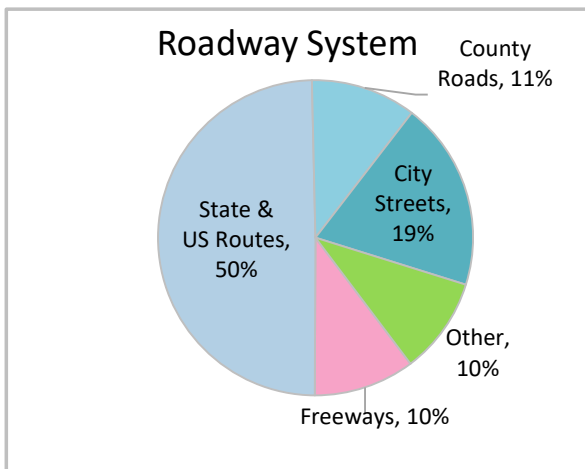
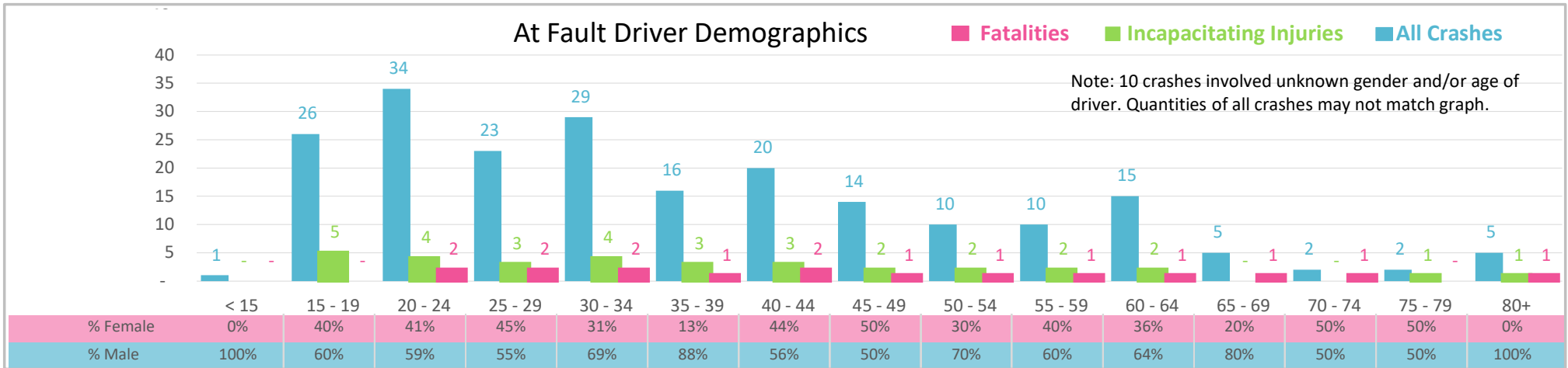

- ### Key Occupant Protection Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 279,238.
 - 51% of crashes involved drivers under 30; male drivers account for 64% of all crashes and 93% fatalities.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 16% of crashes and resulted in 5 fatalities.
 - 50% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on City Streets.
 - Passenger Car accounted for 48% of motor vehicles involved in occupant protection crashes.
 - 42% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 7 fatalities.
