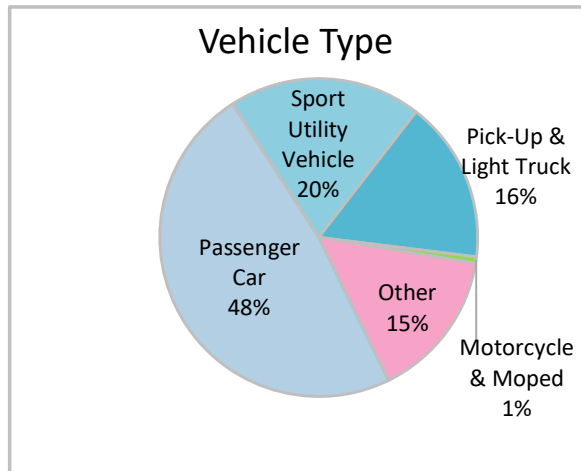
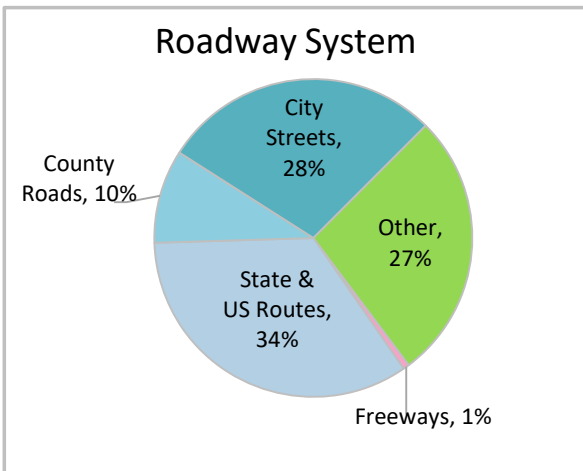
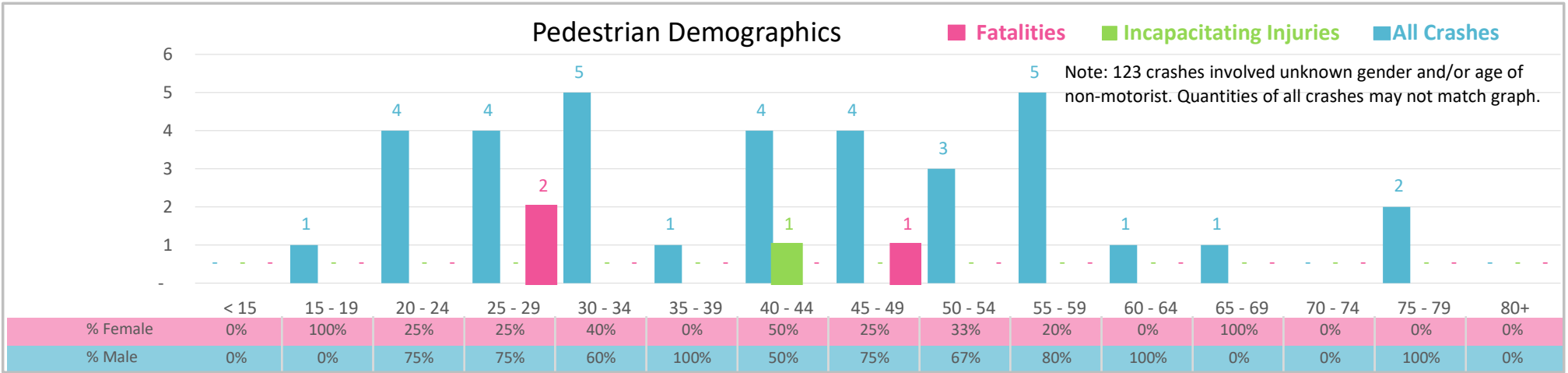

*NOTE: Crash severity is determined from the highest injury type in the crash (i.e. if a crash had both a fatal and a serious it is determined to be a fatal crash).



- ### Key Pedestrian Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 279,238.
 - Pedestrian age is distributed broadly across all age groups; male pedestrians account for 55% of all crashes and 6 fatalities.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 6 crashes and resulted in 1 fatality.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 6 crashes and resulted in 1 fatality.
 - 34% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on City Streets.
 - Passenger car accounted for 48% of the motor vehicles involved in pedestrian crashes
 - 44% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 9 fatalities.
