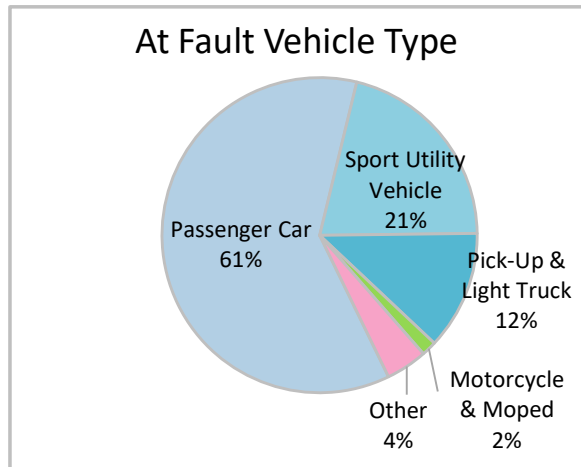
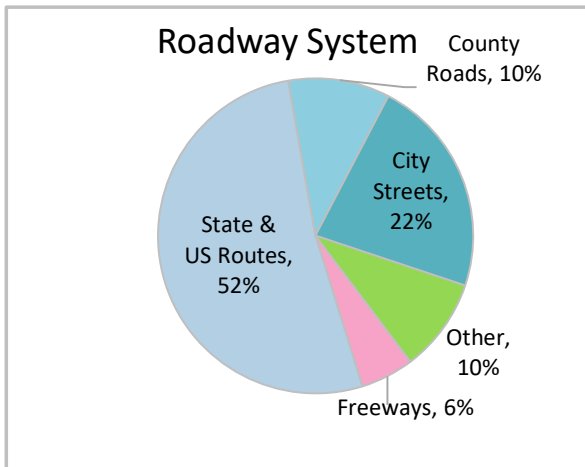
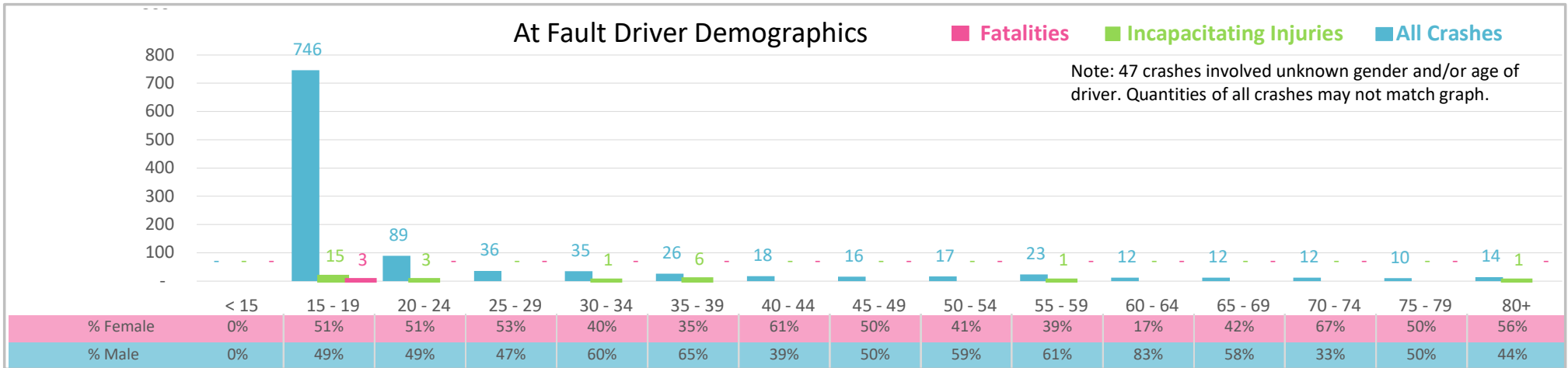

- ### Key Teen Driver Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 279,238.
 - 67% of crashes caused by drivers under 20; male drivers account for 51% of all crashes and 2 of 3 fatalities.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 3% of crashes.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 1% of crashes.
 - 52% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on City Streets.
 - Passenger car accounted for 61% of motor vehicles involved in teen driver crashes.
 - 28% of crashes occurred at night with 1 fatality.
