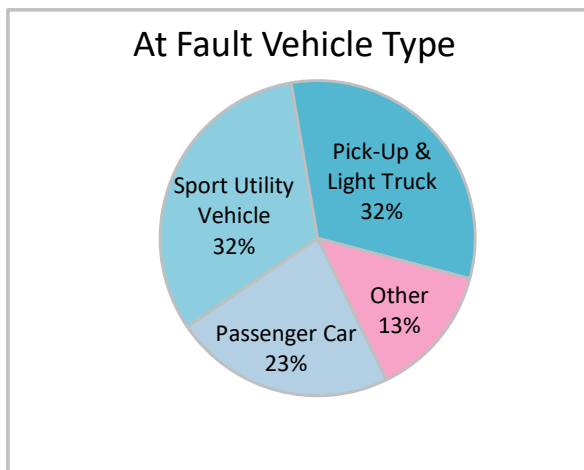
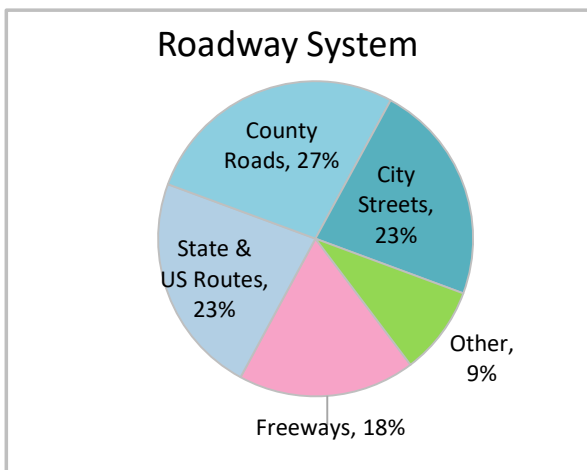
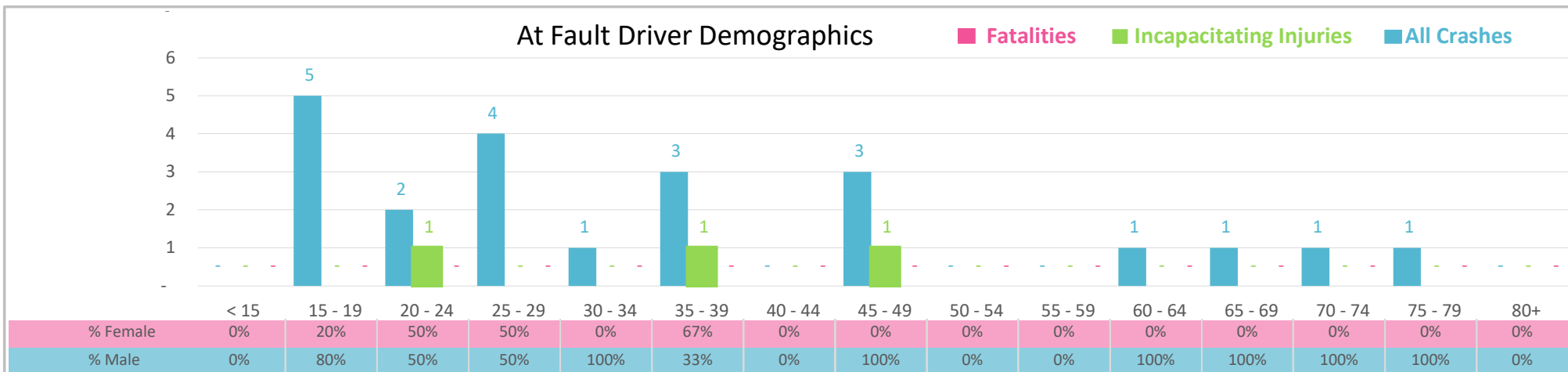

- ### Key Occupant Protection Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 28,715.
 - 50% of crashes involved drivers under 30; male drivers account for 73% of all crashes.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 1 crash.
 - 27% of crashes occurred along County Roads with most of the remainder occurring on City Streets and State and US Routes.
 - Sport utility vehicle and pick-up and light truck each accounted for 32% of motor vehicles involved in occupant protection crashes.
 - 41% of crashes occurred at night.
