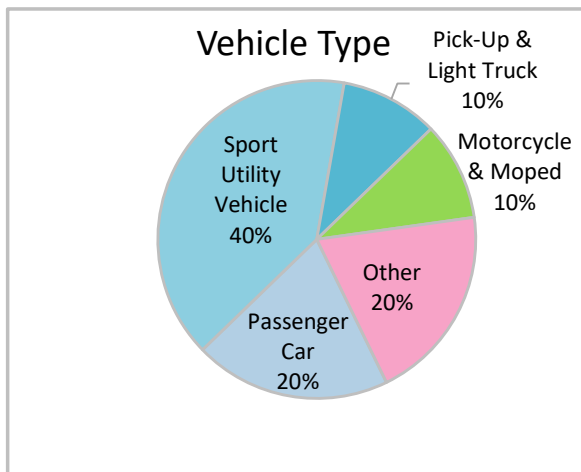
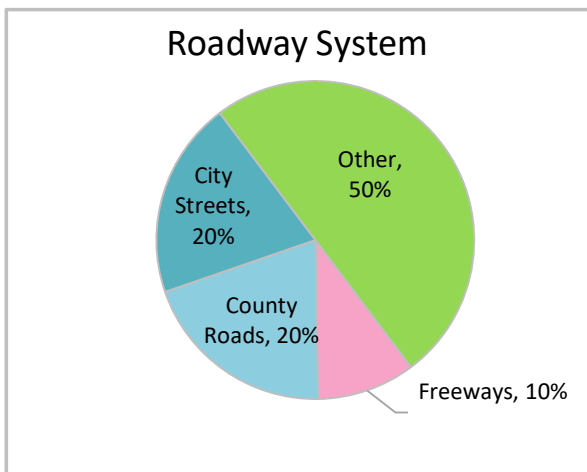
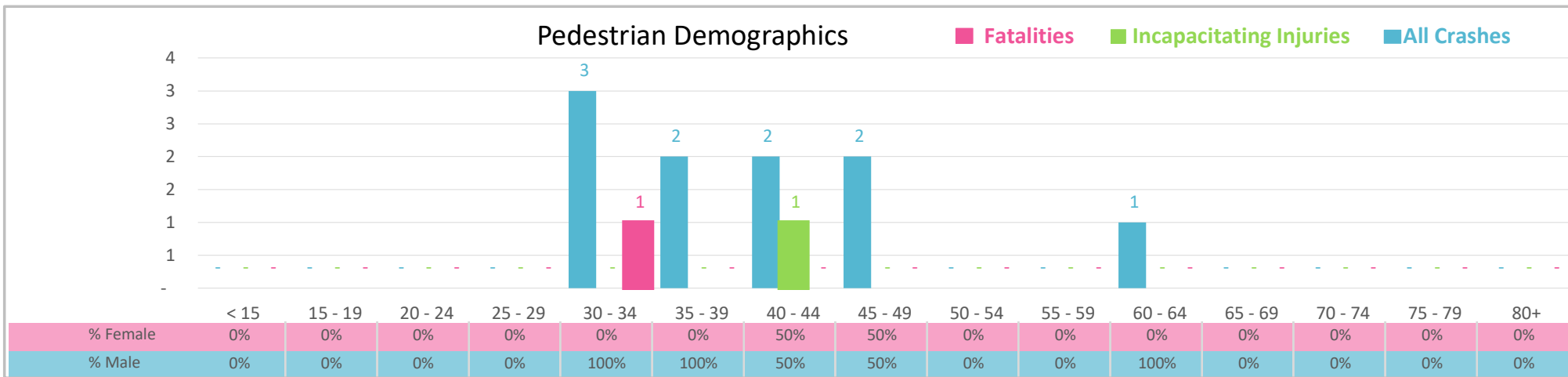

- ### Key Pedestrian Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 28,715.
  - Pedestrian age is distributed broadly across the age groups between 30 and 50; male pedestrians account for 6 of 10 crashes.
  - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 1 crash.
  - Intoxication was not noted as a factor in any of the crashes.
  - 50% of crashes occurred along Other Roadway Systems with most of the remainder occurring on City Streets and County Roads.
  - Sport Utility Vehicles accounted for 40% of the motor vehicles involved in pedestrian crashes.
  - 5 of 10 crashes occurred at night resulting in the 1 fatality.
