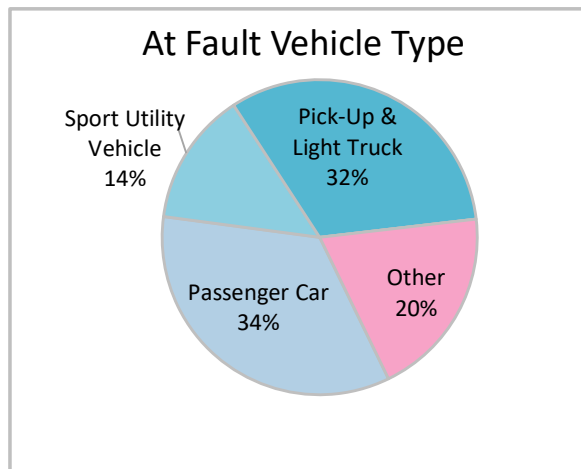
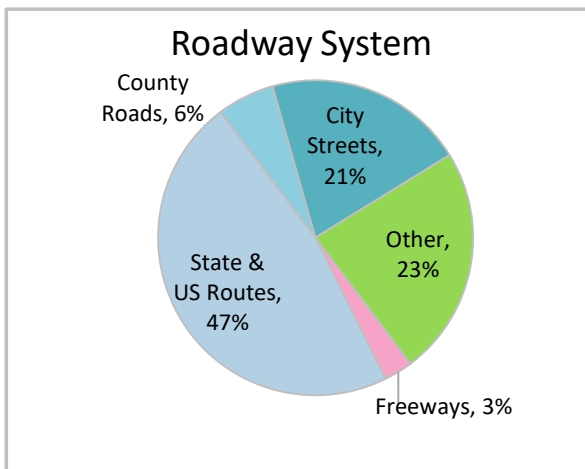
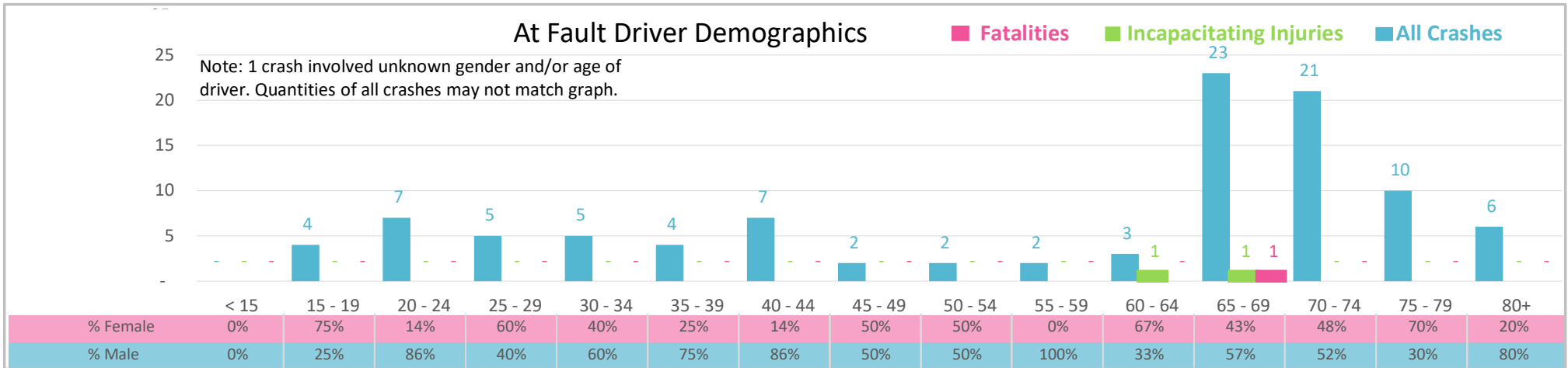

- ### Key Aging Road User Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 28,540.
 - 59% of crashes involved drivers 65 and older; male drivers account for 57% of all crashes and the 1 fatality.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 4 crashes.
 - Intoxication was not noted as a factor in any of the crashes.
 - 47% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on Other roadway systems.
 - Passenger car accounted for 34% of motor vehicles involved in aging driver crashes.
 - 18% of crashes occurred at night resulting in the 1 fatality.
