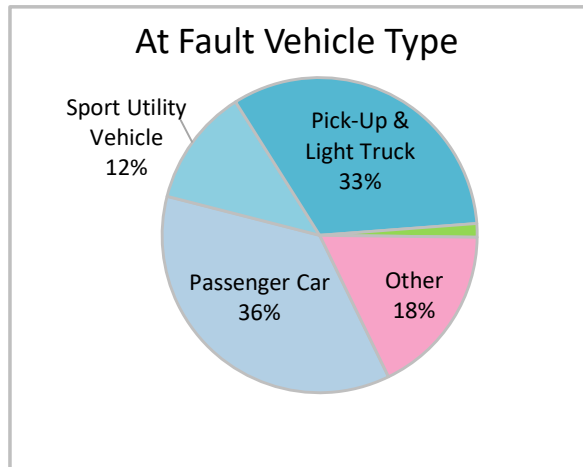
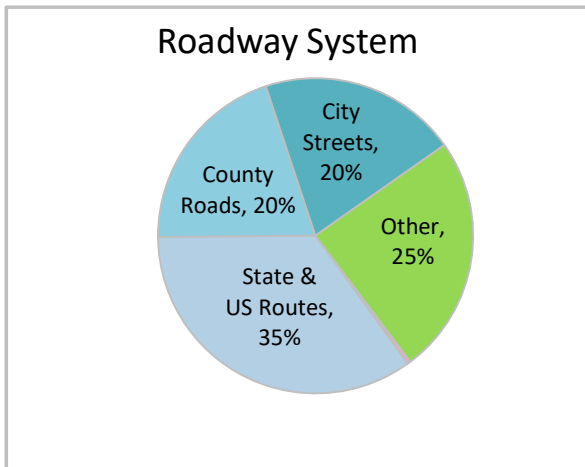
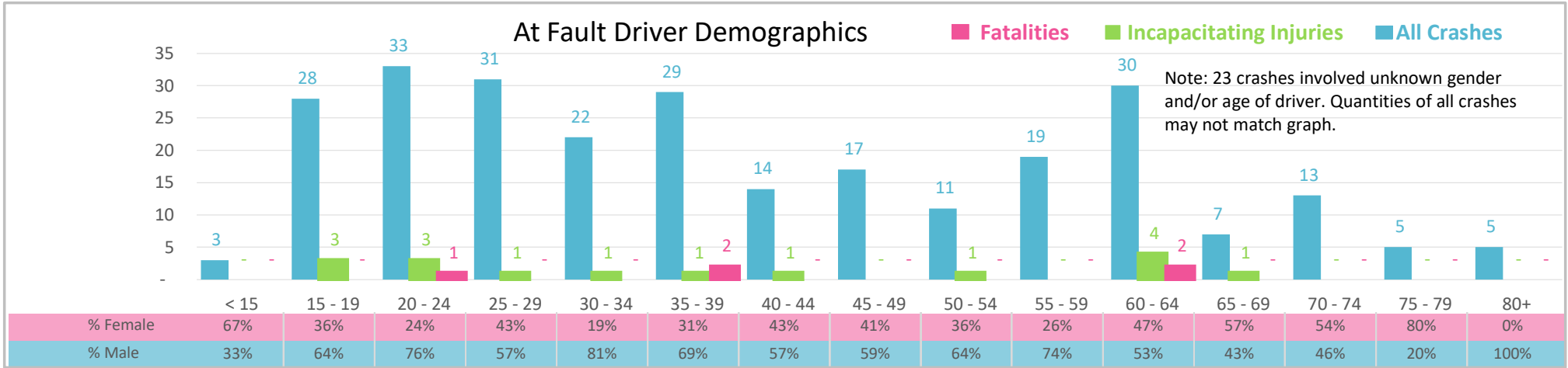

- ### Key Lane Departure Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 28,540.
 - Driver age is distributed broadly across all age groups under 65; male drivers account for 63% of all crashes and 4 fatalities.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 3% of crashes and resulted in 2 fatalities.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 5% of crashes and resulted in 2 fatalities.
 - 35% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on Other roadway systems.
 - Passenger car accounted for 36% of motor vehicles involved in lane departure crashes.
 - 44% of crashes occurred at night with 4 fatalities.
