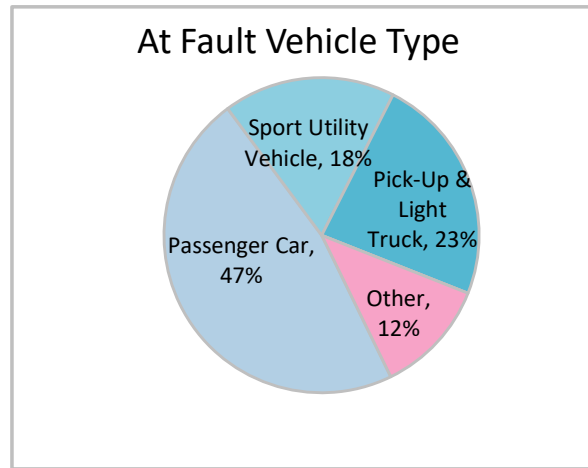
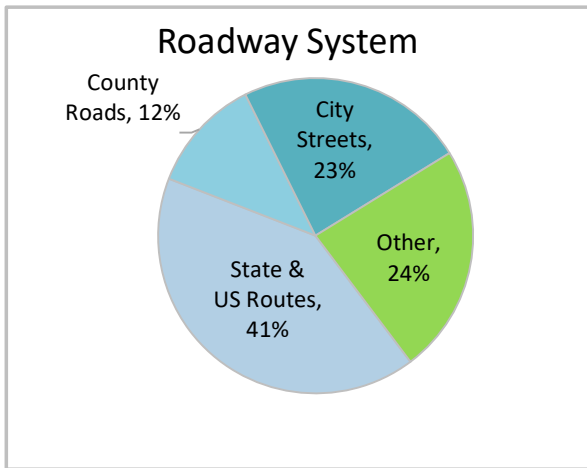
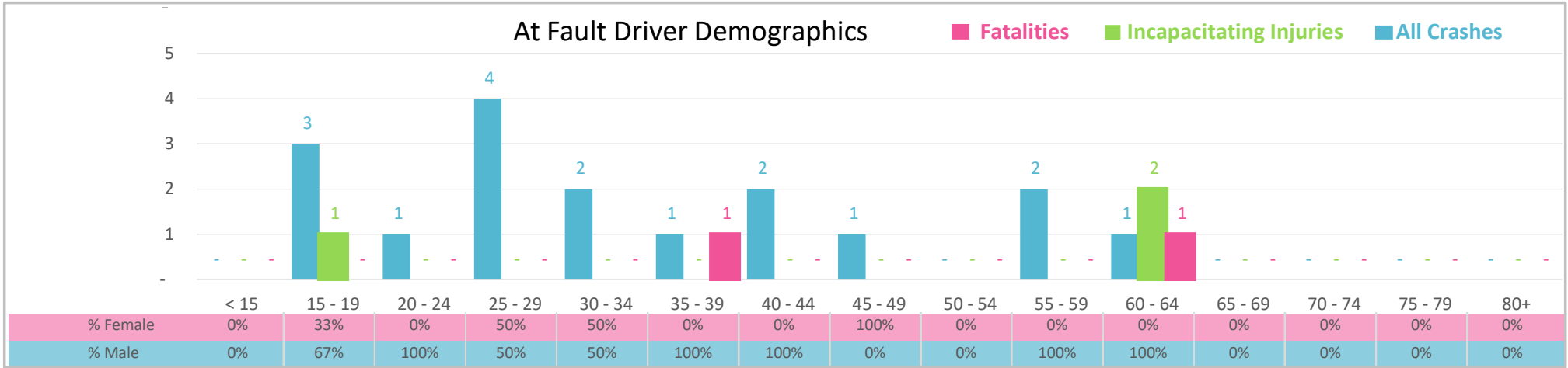

- ### Key Occupant Protection Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 28,540.
 - 47% of crashes involved drivers under 30; male drivers account for 71% of all crashes and 2 fatalities.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 2 crashes with 1 fatality.
 - 41% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on Other roadway systems.
 - Passenger car accounted for 47% of motor vehicles involved in occupant protection crashes.
 - 59% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 2 fatalities.
