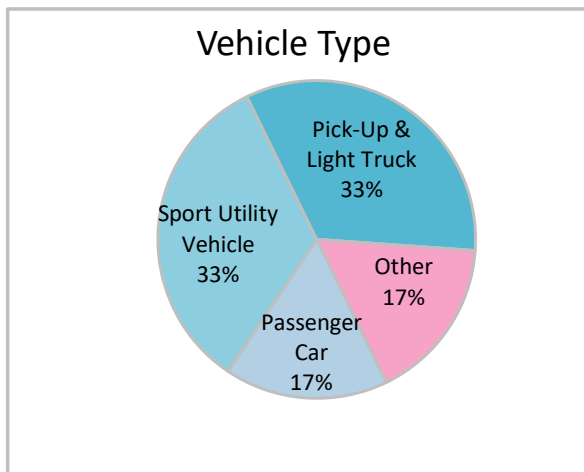
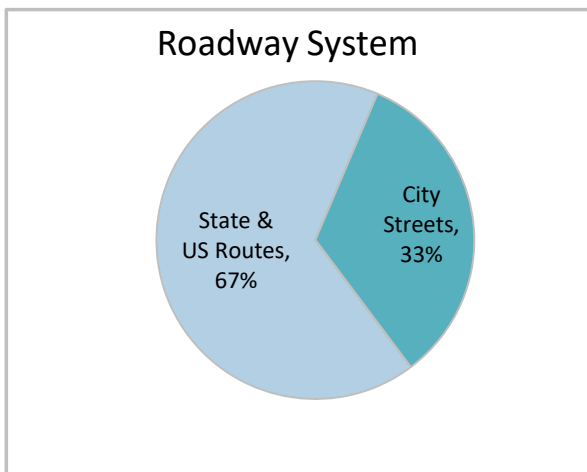
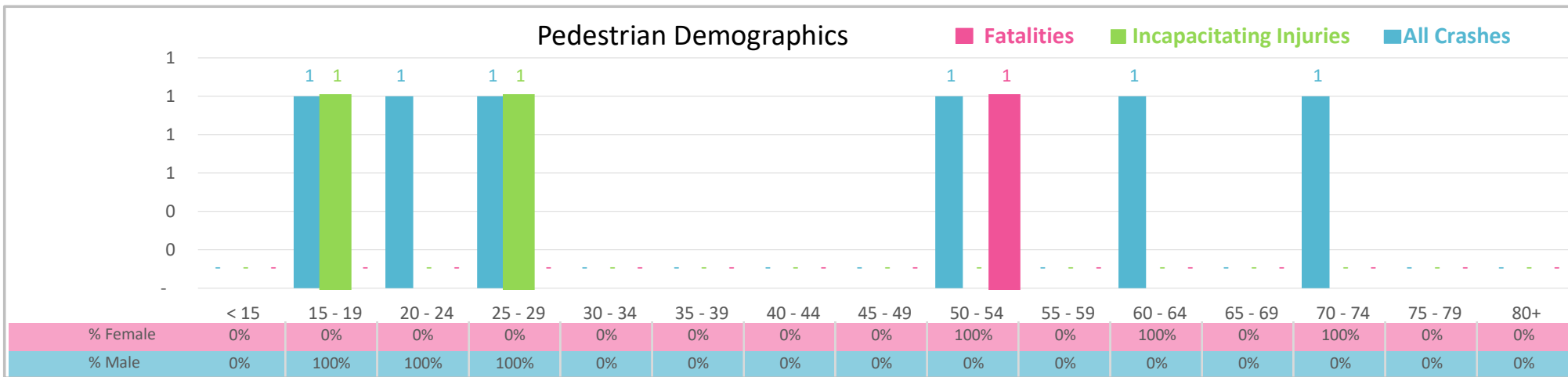

- ### Key Pedestrian Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 28,540.
  - Pedestrian age is distributed broadly across all age groups; male pedestrians account for 4 of 6 crashes and the 1 fatality.
  - Unrestrained occupant was not noted as a factor in any of the crashes.
  - Intoxication was not noted as a factor in any of the crashes.
  - 67% of crashes occurred along State and US and the remainder occurring on City Streets.
  - Pick-Up and Light Truck and Sport Utility Vehicles each accounted for 33% of the motor vehicles involved in pedestrian crashes.
  - 4 of 6 crashes occurred at night resulting in the 1 fatality.
