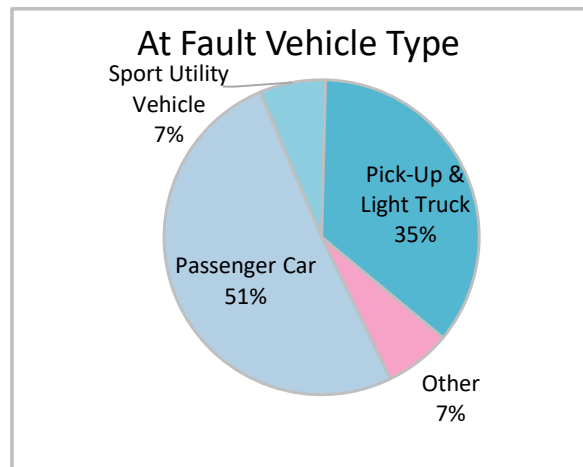
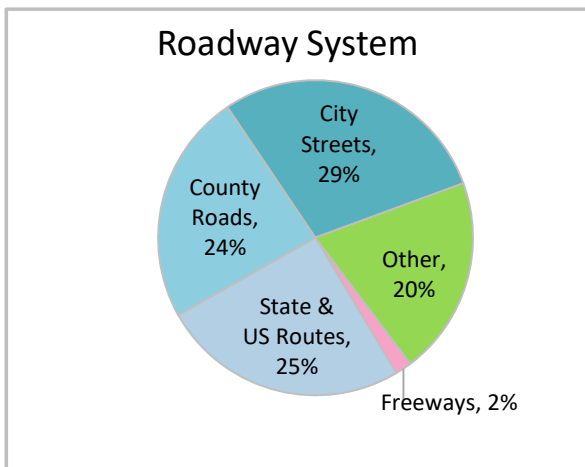
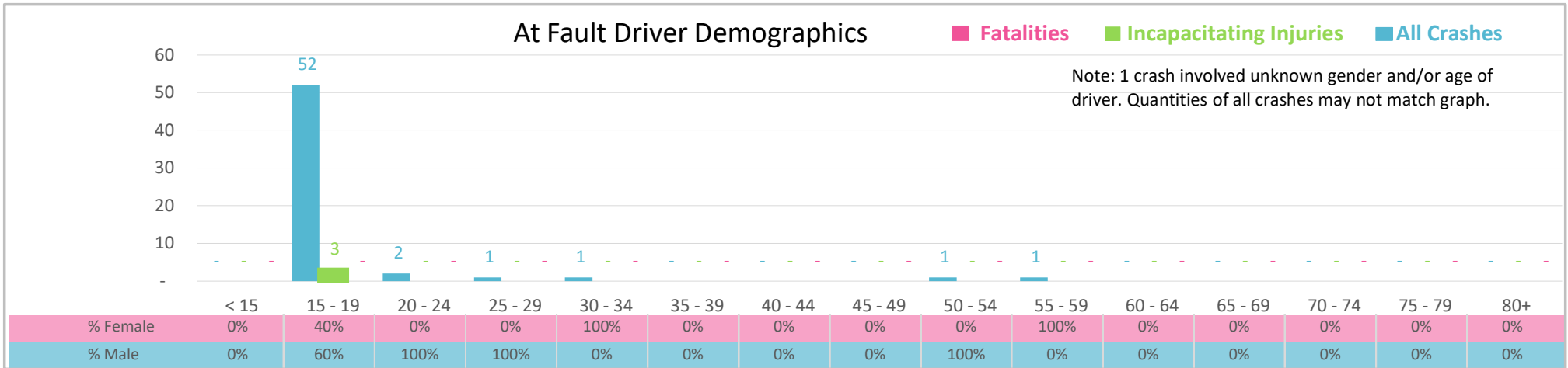

- ### Key Teen Driver Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 28,540.
  - 88% of crashes involved drivers under 20; male drivers account for 60% of all crashes.
  - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 3 crashes.
  - Intoxication was not noted as a factor in any of the crashes.
  - Crashes occurred mostly distributed along all roadway systems with highest on City Streets, 29%.
  - Passenger car accounted for 51% of motor vehicles involved in teen driver crashes.
  - 42% of crashes occurred at night.
