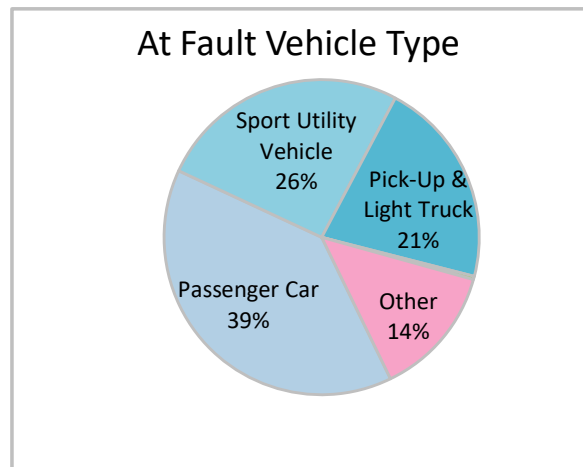
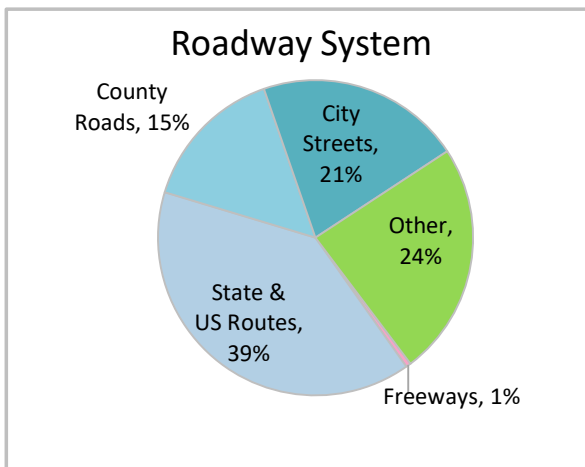
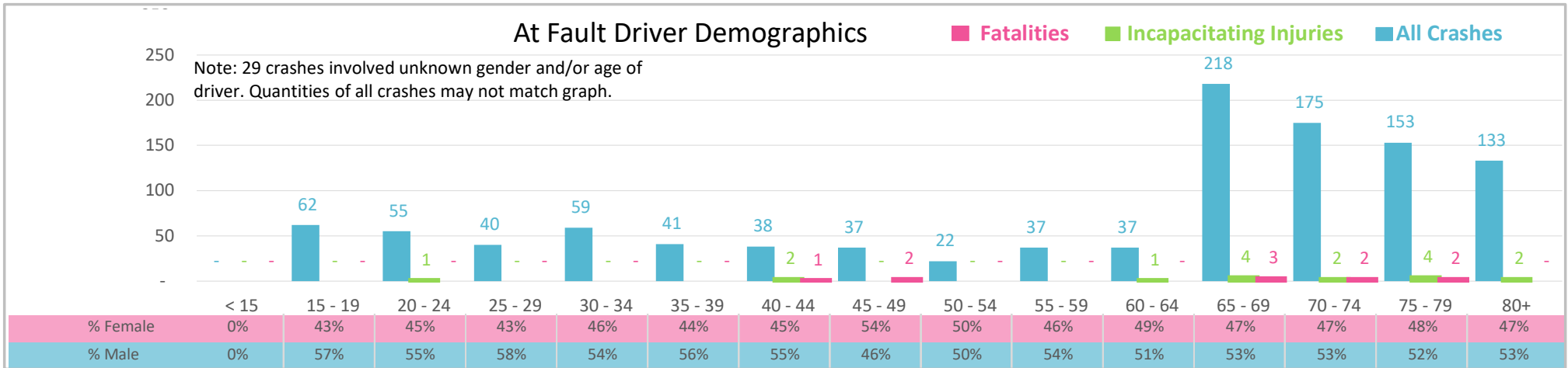

- ### Key Aging Road User Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 222,361.
 - 60% of crashes involved drivers 65 and older; male drivers account for 54% of all crashes and 8 of 10 fatalities.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 1% of crashes and resulted in 1 fatality.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 7 crashes.
 - 39% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on Other roadway systems.
 - Passenger car accounted for 39% of motor vehicles involved in aging driver crashes.
 - 11% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 6 fatalities.
