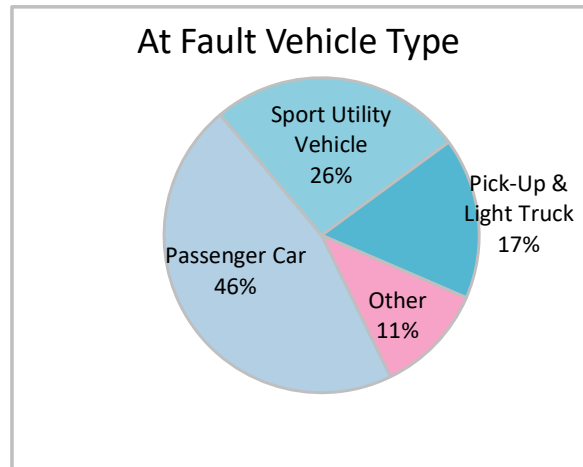
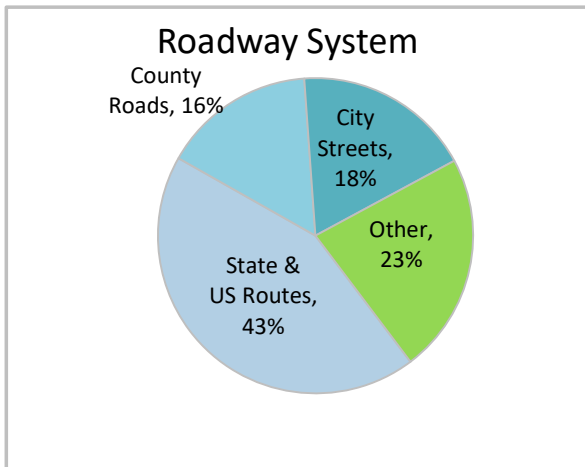
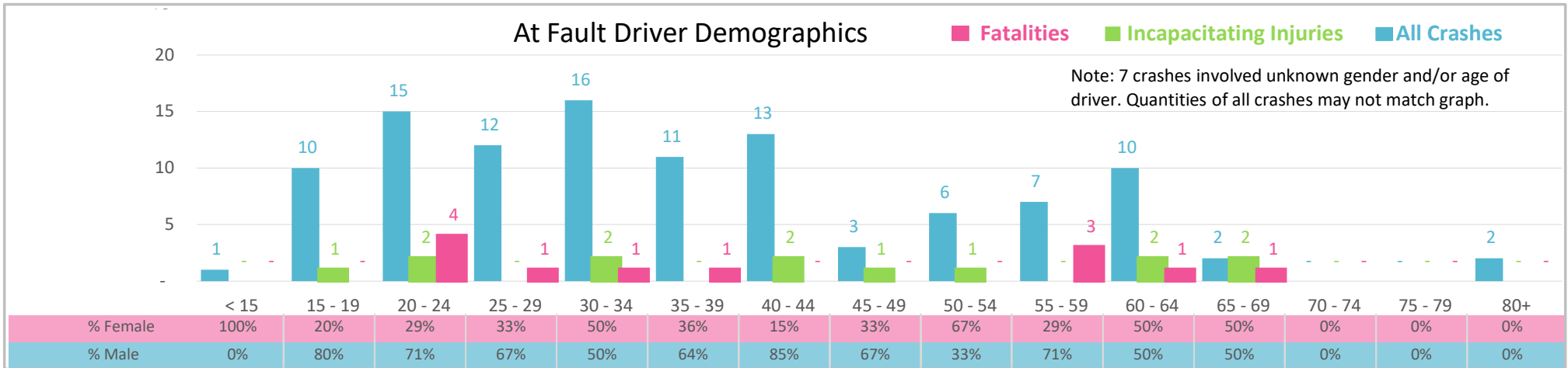

- ### Key Occupant Protection Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 222,361.
  - Driver age is distributed broadly across all age groups under 45; male drivers account for 65% of all crashes and 12 fatalities.
  - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 18% of crashes with 9 fatalities.
  - 43% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on Other roadway systems.
  - Passenger car accounted for 46% of motor vehicles involved in occupant protection crashes.
  - 46% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 6 fatalities.
