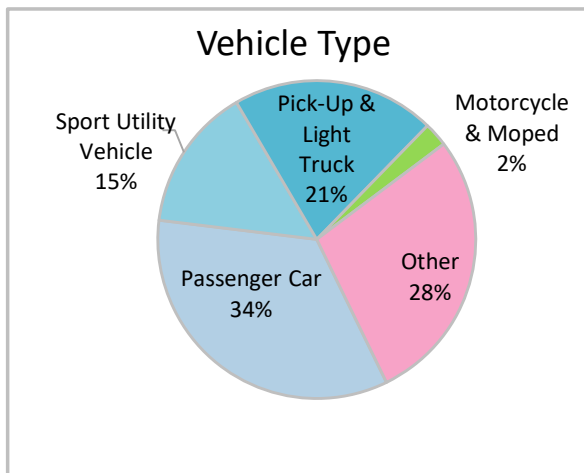
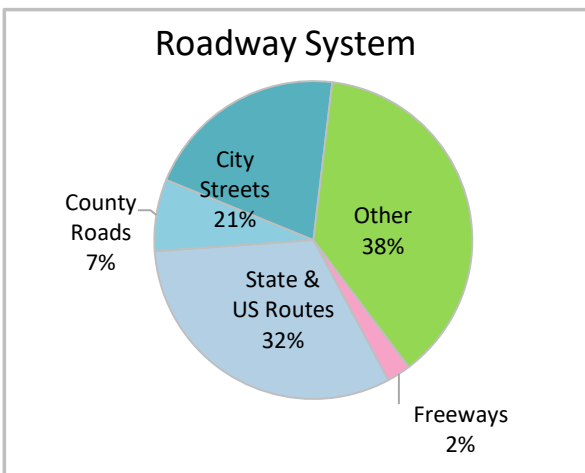
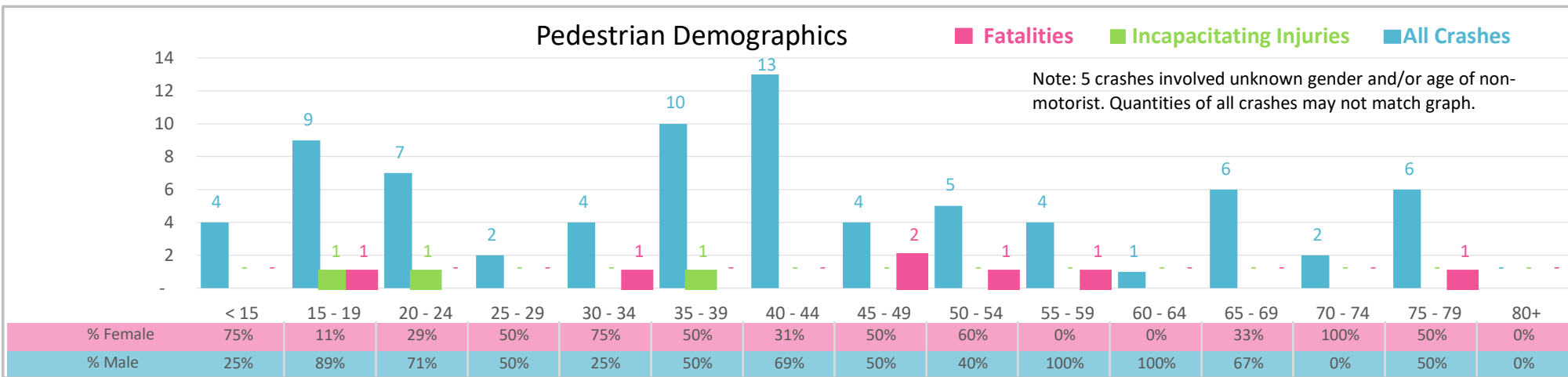

*NOTE: Crash severity is determined from the highest injury type in the crash (i.e. if a crash had both a fatal and a serious it is determined to be a fatal crash).



- ### Key Pedestrian Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 222,361.
 - Pedestrian age is distributed broadly across the age groups under 80; male pedestrians account for 58% of all crashes.
 - Unrestrained occupant was not noted as a factor in any of the crashes.
 - Intoxication was not noted as a factor in any of the crashes.
 - 38% of crashes occurred along Other Roadway Systems with most of the remainder occurring on State and US Routes.
 - Passenger car accounted for 34% of the motor vehicles involved in pedestrian crashes.
 - 35% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 5 fatalities.
