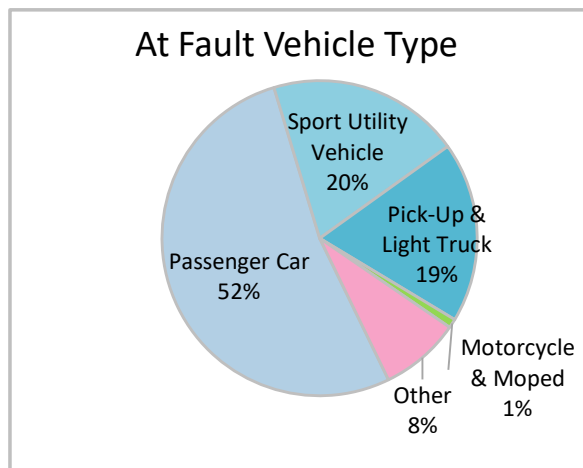
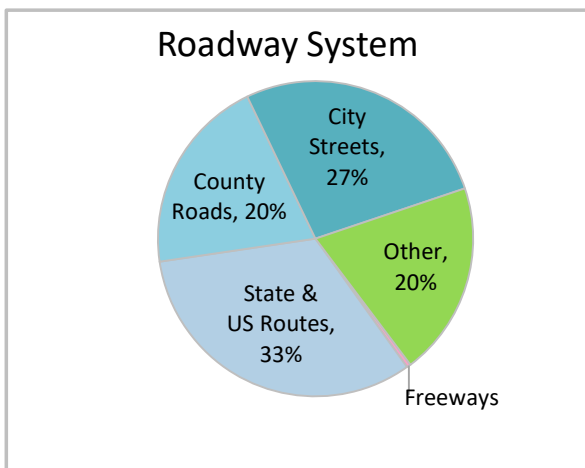
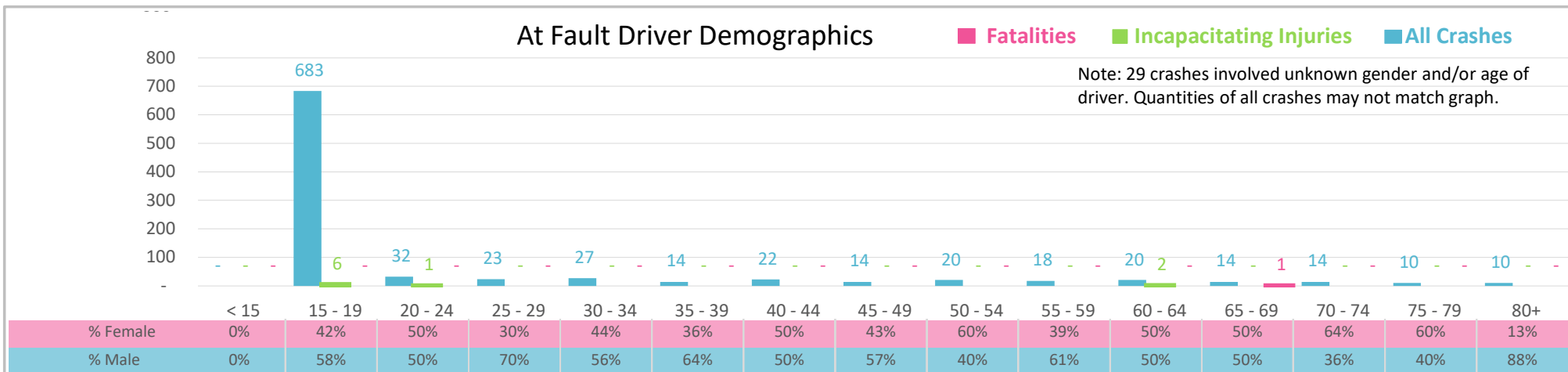

- ### Key Teen Driver Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 222,361.
 - 72% of crashes involved drivers under 20; male drivers account for 57% of all crashes and the 1 fatality.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 1% of crashes.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 2 crashes.
 - Crashes occurred mostly distributed along all roadway systems with highest on State and US Routes, 33%.
 - Passenger car accounted for 52% of motor vehicles involved in teen driver crashes.
 - 25% of crashes occurred at night.
