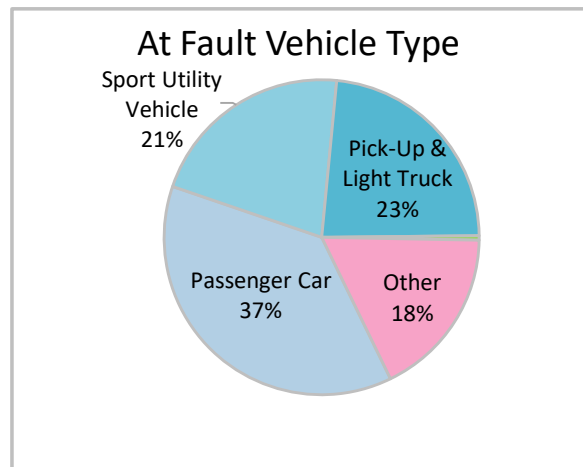
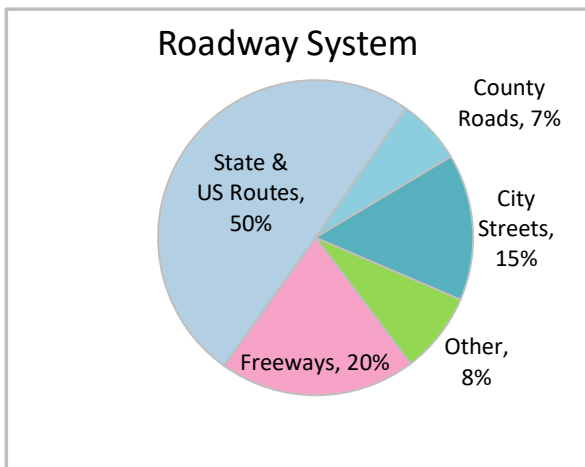
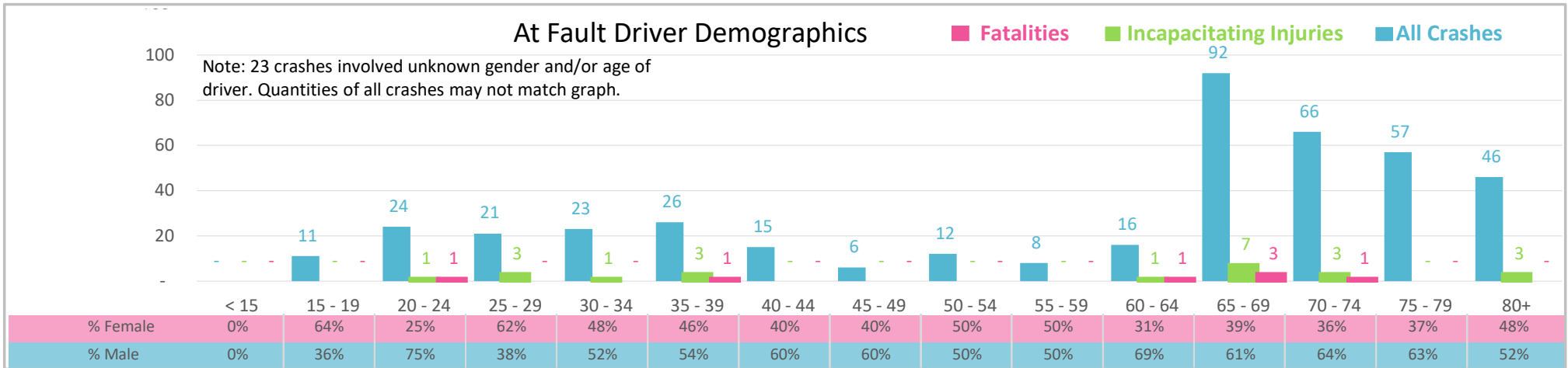

- ### Key Aging Road User Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 70,385.
 - 59% of crashes involved drivers 65 and older; male drivers account for 59% of all crashes and the 7 fatalities.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 4% of crashes and resulted in 3 fatalities.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 9 crashes.
 - 50% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on Freeways.
 - Passenger car accounted for 37% of motor vehicles involved in aging driver crashes.
 - 15% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 5 fatalities.
