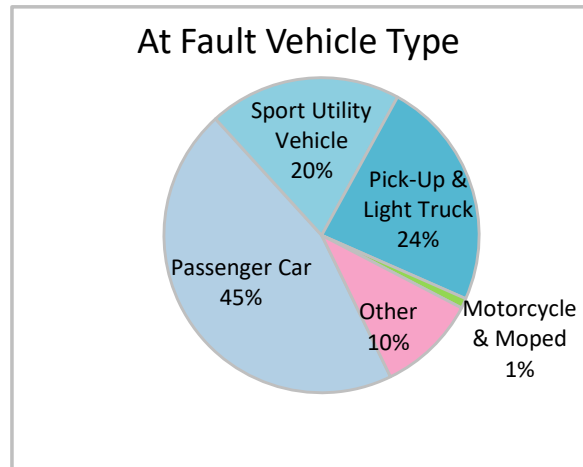
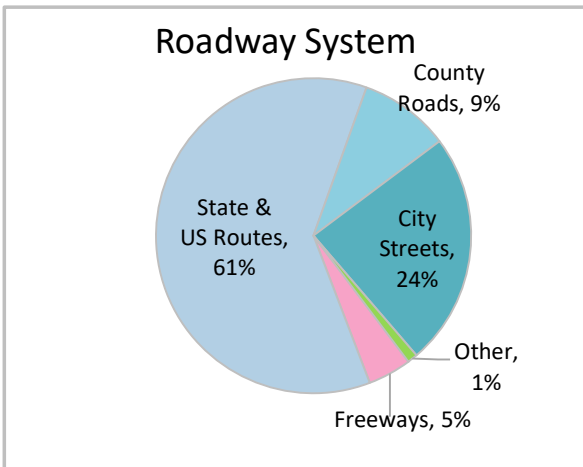
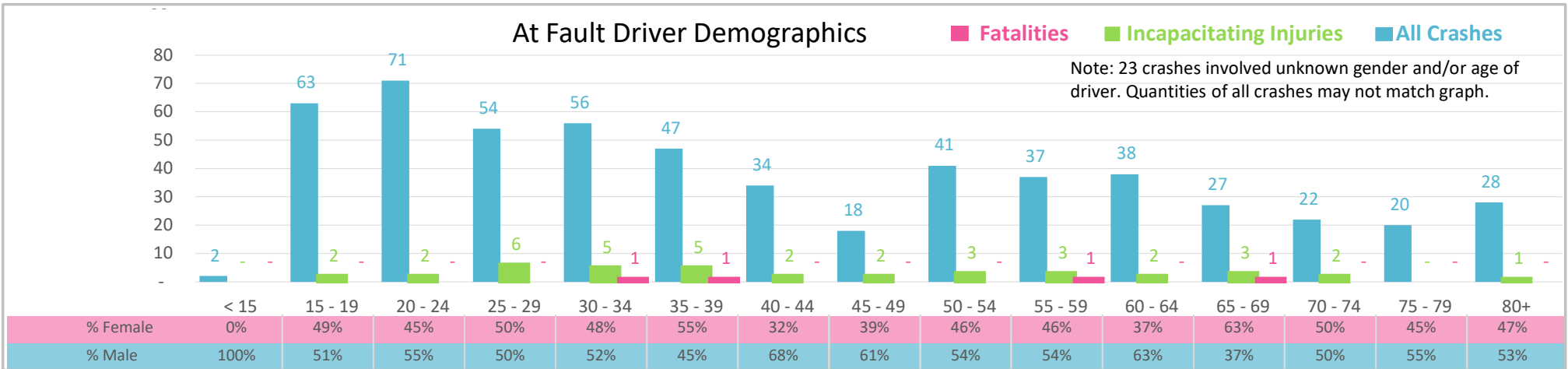

*NOTE: Crash severity is determined from the highest injury type in the crash (i.e. if a crash had both a fatal and a serious it is determined to be a fatal crash).



- ### Key Intersection Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 70,385.
 - 50% of crashes involved drivers under 40; male drivers account for 54% of all crashes and the 4 fatalities.
 - Unrestrained occupant was noted as a factor in 5% of crashes and resulted in 3 fatalities.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 4% of crashes.
 - 61% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on City Streets.
 - Passenger car accounted for 45% of motor vehicles involved in intersection crashes.
 - 18% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 2 fatalities.
