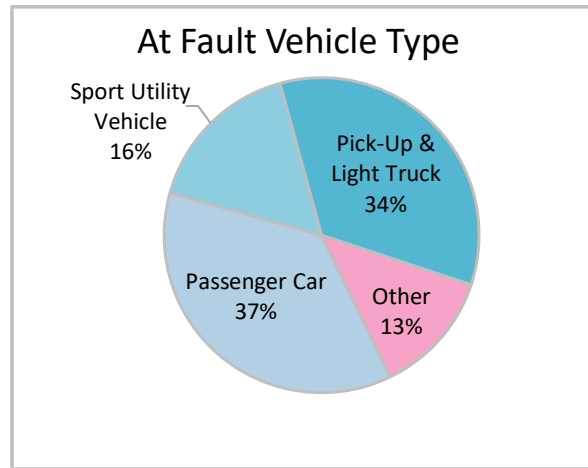
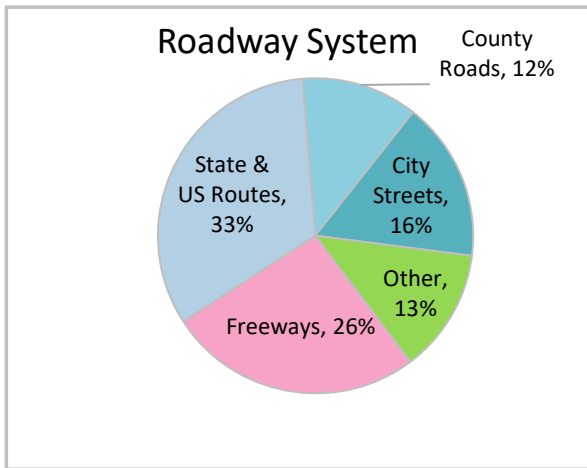
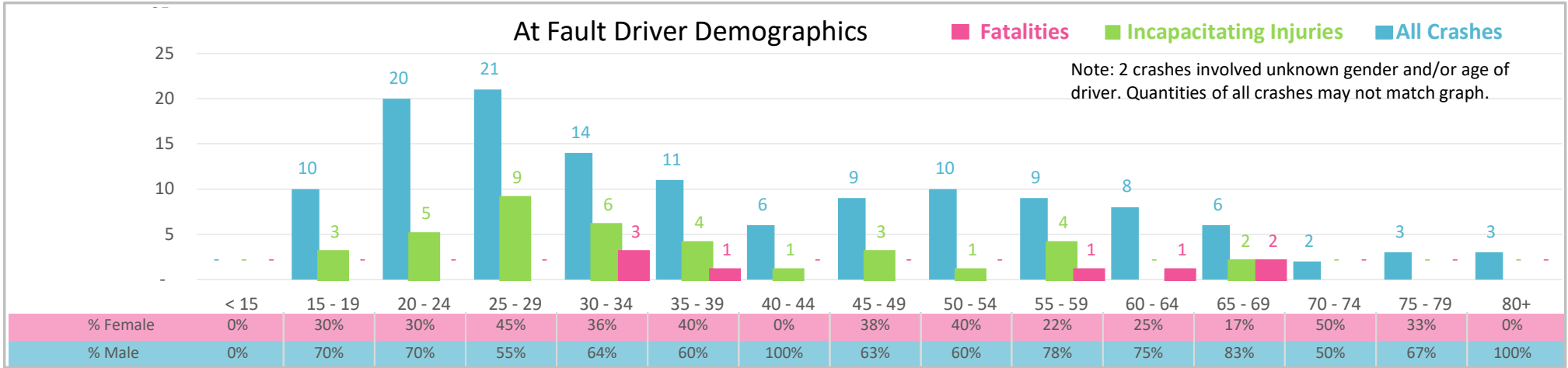

- ### Key Occupant Protection Crash Facts
- 2021 population of 70,385.
 - Driver age is distributed broadly across all age groups under 60; male drivers account for 68% of all crashes and 6 fatalities.
 - Intoxication was noted as a factor in 13% of crashes.
 - 33% of crashes occurred along State and US Routes with most of the remainder occurring on Freeways.
 - Passenger car accounted for 37% of motor vehicles involved in occupant protection crashes.
 - 49% of crashes occurred at night resulting in 7 fatalities.
